United Food Bank mobile food distribution in Kearny more vital than ever; next one scheduled for Nov 1

Every month on the first Friday, United Food Bank delivers a truckload of food to Kearny for folks in need. The food bank typically serves around 80 people each month.

This month, due to the ongoing strike at Asarco's Ray Mine and Hayden Smelter, United Food Bank will be bringing additional food to assist families impacted by the prolonged strike. The food bank estimates that nearly 1,700 people are impacted by the strike.

The Copper Basin is part of Mesa-based United Food Bank's 19,000-square-mile service area and is served by a mobile food distribution on the first Friday of each month. United Food Bank expects to serve 300 people at the next distribution event.

The next food distribution is set for Friday, Nov. 1, at 8 a.m. United Food Bank will distribute food until 10 a.m. or when the food runs out. To accommodate the anticipated increase in people served, United Food Bank has made arrangements to move the distribution site from the courthouse where it normally has been held to Church of the Good Shepherd at 617 Senator Chastain Rd.

There are no income requirements to receive the assistance. "If you are hungry, we want to feed you," a representative of the food bank said.

PINAL COUNTY. ARIZONA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: SECTION I: Amend the Town's Official

Zoning Map to change the following parcels, described as being Assessor's Parcel Numbers 105-03-0120; 105-11-0920; 105-11-0930; 105-11-0940; 105-22-040A; 105-22-040B; 105-22-040C; 105-22-040D 105-22-040E; 040F, located at Section 04, Township 02S, Range 12E in Superior, from the Urban Residential (R1-8) Zone District to the Multiple Family Residentia (R-3) Zone District as well as attached Exhibits "A" through "D" to this Ordinance

as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION II: The Town The Town hereby given the authority to make any non-substantive changes to Ordinance No. 19-161. These non-substantive changes will include such things as grammatical errors, errors in mathematical calculations, erroneous references in the Zoning Ordinance changes in formatting, or any other such changes provided a report is given to the Town Council indicating which changes are to be made.

SECTION III: Severability. If any section

subsection, subdivision, sentence, phrase or portion of Ordinance No. 19-161. or the application to any person or place is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council declares that it would have adopted Ordinance No. 19-161, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this zone change in spite of the fact that one or more of the same be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
