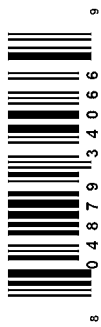

# Town of Superior sends delegation to Washington D.C.

Superior Mayor Mila Besich, Councilwoman Vanessa Navarrette and Town Manager Todd Pryor tended to official Town of Superior business in Washington D.C. last week.

The trip included a total of 11 meetings with the Arizona's Congressional Delegation along with agency officials at the Economic Development Administration, Environmental

Protection Agency, Army Corps of Engineers and the Forest Service. The meetings were focused on the Town's need for federal funding for the Multi-Gen and Entrepreneur Center and addressing the Town's comment letter to the Resolution Copper Draft Environmental Impact Statement.

During the October Council meeting, the Superior Town

Council hired Nexxus Consulting to assist the Town with Federal lobbying.

"Our trip was fast and efficient," explained Mayor Besich. "I truly appreciate the time and focus that our Arizona Congressmen gave to us during our meetings and all of the agency officials provided us with additional information on resources that can support our projects."

United Food Bank mobile food distribution in Kearny more vital than ever; next one scheduled for Nov. 1

Every month on the first Friday, United Food Bank delivers a truckload of food to Kearny for folks in need. The food bank typically serves around 80 people each month.

This month, due to the ongoing strike at Asarco's Ray Mine and Hayden Smelter, United Food Bank will be bringing additional food to assist families impacted by the prolonged strike. The food bank estimates that nearly 1,700 people are impacted by the strike.

The Copper Basin is part of Mesa-based United Food Bank's 19,000-square-mile service area and is served by a mobile food distribution on the first Friday of each month. United Food Bank expects to serve 300 people at the next distribution event.

The next food distribution is set for Friday, Nov. 1, at 8 a.m. United Food Bank will distribute food until 10 a.m. or when the food runs out. To accommodate the anticipated increase in people served, United Food Bank has made arrangements to move the distribution site from the courthouse where it normally has been held to Church of the Good Shepherd at 617 Senator Chastain Rd.

There are no income requirements to receive the assistance. "If you are hungry, we want to feed you," a representative of the food bank said.

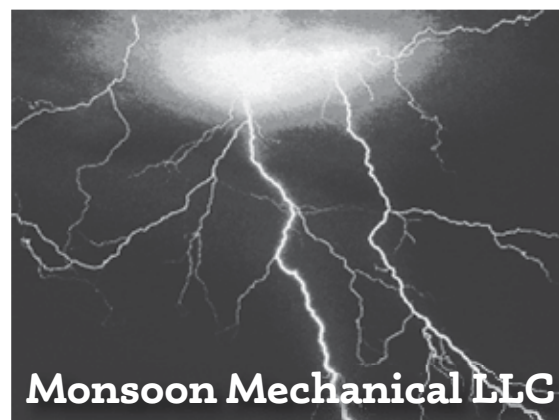

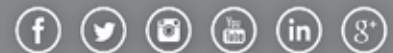

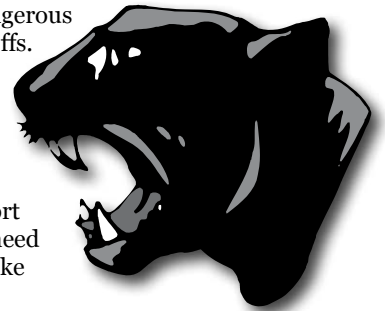
The Panthers are heavily favored, as they should be, but
