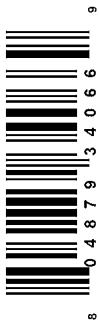

A flow test will be conducted in Queen Creek starting Nov. 1.

Queen Creek discharge test to release water in the creek starting Nov. 1

The Town of Superior has announced that a flow test is scheduled to take place in Queen Creek during the month of November 2023.

The Town of Superior, in collaboration with Arizona Water Company and other stakeholders, will conduct this test to better understand how water flows through the Queen Creek stream channel.

Here are some key details about the upcoming flow test:

- **Preparation:** The water discharge equipment is in place, and it was commissioned on October 18 when a minimal amount of water was discharged into the creek for about one hour.
- **Location:** The flow test will occur just north of the bridge where South Magma Avenue crosses Queen Creek.
- **Duration:** The test will run from November 1 to November 30.
- **Purpose:** The primary objective of this test is to assess how the creek responds to increased water flows during dry periods. The goal is to improve the flow in the creek.

• **Water Safety:** The water being released into the creek is from Arizona Water Company and is the same water that services town residents. This controlled release is aimed at providing valuable scientific data for possible future restoration efforts. In accordance with an Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) discharge permit, chlorine is removed from the water prior to discharge to minimize impacts to the environment.

This initiative, like the flow test that was conducted in April 2023, reflects the Town's dedication to enhancing the environment and the water quality in Queen Creek. By conducting this flow test and implementing a long-term restoration plan, the Town aims to preserve and improve the creek's and surrounding ecosystem's health. As these plans progress, the town will share more.

Early childhood agency funds programs in Pinal County to help prepare children for kindergarten

As Arizona's early childhood agency, First Things First (FTF) is pleased to announce the investment of \$5.2 million in early childhood programs in the FTF Pinal Region, which includes the cities/towns of Casa Grande, Maricopa, Florence, Coolidge, Eloy, Apache Junction, San Tan Valley and the Copper Corridor. - Parenting education
- Developmental and sensory screenings
- Oral health screenings
- Quality First
- Family, Friend and Neighbor Care
- Smart Support

Over the past year, volunteers who serve on the FTF Pinal Regional Partnership Council studied the needs

of young children in their communities in order to recommend to the FTF state Board how best to address those needs. At its May and June meetings, the Board approved grants to organizations that will implement the selected strategies.

"So much happens in the early years for children," said FTF Pinal Regional Director Katrina DeViny. "The programs we fund lend support to parents and families during these years as children are in the most important developmental stages of their lives."

The free programs which are available to parents of babies, toddlers and preschoolers include:

- A series of group parenting classes proven to increase your understanding of child development and improve your parenting skills, provided by the Apache Junction Public Library Fun Van.
- Having your child checked for dental, vision, hearing

or developmental concerns (including communication, social-emotional, problem solving and motor skills) and, if needed, get a referral for further evaluation or support. These screenings are provided by the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension program.

- Working one-on-one with a trained and caring parent educator, in the convenience of your own home to build on the parenting skills you already have and nurture your child's health, development and learning. This voluntary home visitation program called Parents as Teachers is provided by EasterSeals Blake Foundation.
- Learning how you can better support the health, development and learning of the young children in your care through health and safety practices, educational activities and understanding more about child development. The Family, Friend and Neighbor Care

International Mining Symposium visits Superior

The US Forest Service International Mining Symposium visited the Superior Town Hall during their two-week conference.

During their visit to Superior, the group heard a panel discussion from Mila Besich, Superior Mayor, Manny

Guzman, President of Rebuild Superior Inc., and Todd Pryor, Superior Town Manager. The panel spoke about their experiences working through the Resolution Copper Environmental Impact Statement and governing a community that is connected to the

mineral extraction industry.

The group also visited the Resolution Copper and met with officials from the company. During their two-week visit to the United States, members of the symposium also heard a presentation from the Tonto National Forest and

visited many mine sites.

This was the first time the symposium was hosted since the Covid pandemic began in 2020. Participants were attending from Moldova, Indonesia, Russia, Jamaica, Peru, Zimbabwe and Ghana.

Congratulations, Miners, on your Regional title and a great season!

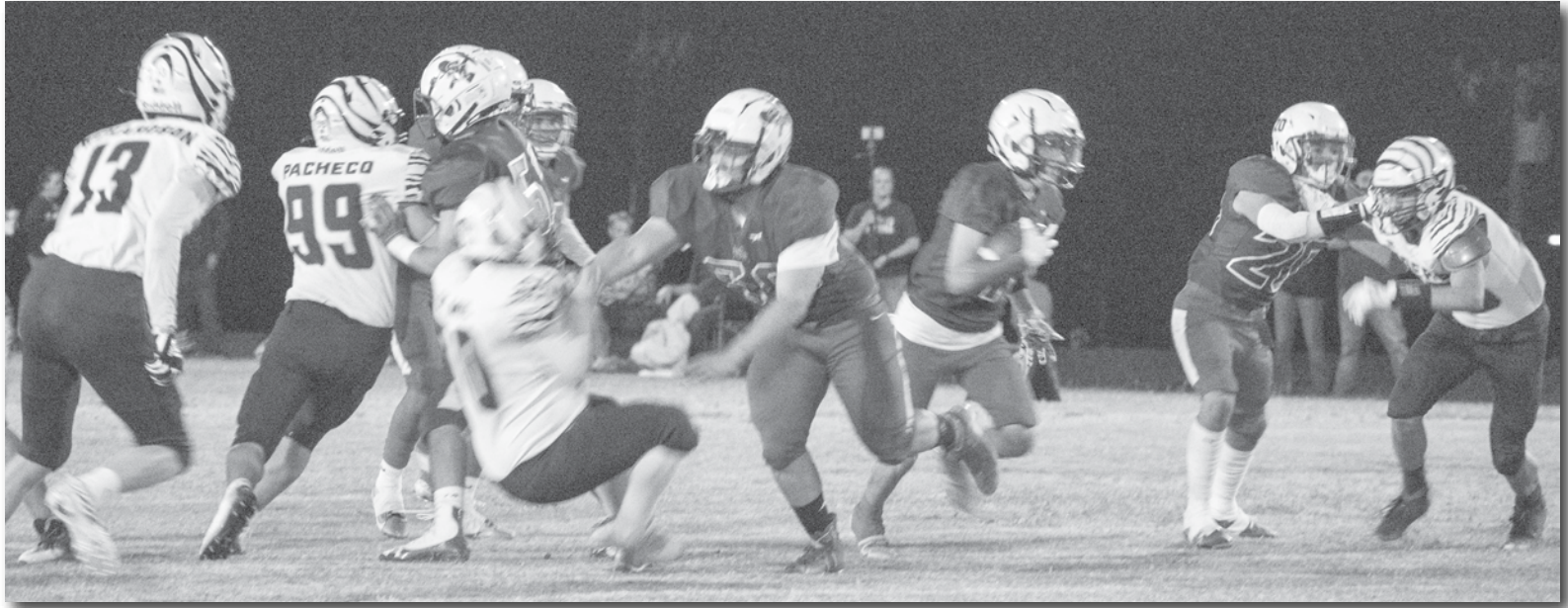

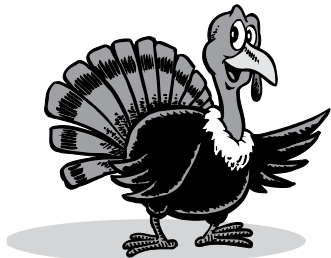

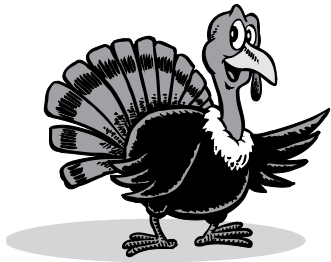
