

### ADOT adjusts times of full closures of SR 77 for rock blasting operations; Overnight closures between 8 p.m. and 2 a.m. begin Sunday, Nov. 6

Motorists traveling on State Route 77 south of Globe will encounter full closures of the highway beginning and ending earlier than previous closures for a rock removal project in the Dripping Springs area.

There will be no full closures of SR 77 next week, but closures between mileposts 154 and 161 will resume the week of Nov. 6 and continue Sunday nights through Thursday nights between 8 p.m. and 2 a.m. through late January 2017.

Daytime flagging operations will continue daily in the project area Monday, Oct. 31 through Thursday, Nov. 3 and motorists should plan for 15 minute delays.

When full closures for blasting operations resume Sunday, Nov. 6, motorists can

use State Route 177 and US 60 to get around the closure. The detour adds approximately one hour to travel times. After full nighttime closures resume, the daytime flagging operations will continue as well through late January 2017. ADOT works to inform the public about planned highway restrictions, but it's possible that unscheduled closures or restrictions might occur because of weather or other factors. ## Third hawk illegally killed in Tucson area

TUCSON, Ariz. - The third hawk illegally killed in Tucson area since Sept. 7 was discovered Sunday, and the Arizona Game and Fish Department's Operation Game Thief is offering a \$250 reward for information leading to an arrest in the case

The Harris's hawk was found in the Canyon Del Oro wash in Catalina after apparently being shot in the head approximately 6:30 p.m. Saturday near North Lago Del Oro and East Wilds Road.

"This is the third time since early September that a poacher has stolen wildlife from the citizens of Arizona by illegally killing a hawk," said Regional Supervisor Raul Vega of Game and Fish in Tucson. "These acts are crimes against state as well as federal laws."

Illegal take of wildlife is punishable by up to a \$750 fine and six months in jail under state law. Violations of the U.S. Migratory Bird Treaty Act are punishable by a maximum fine of \$15,000 or imprisonment for up to six months.

Individuals with information about the case are asked to contact Operation Game Thief at 1-800-352-0700, 24-hours-aday, seven days a week, anonymously if need be. They should reference OGT#16-003653. Information may also be provided on-line at http://www.azgfd.gov/ogt\_ form.shtml.

title, led 52 - 0 at halftime.





# Miner swimmers sizzle at regional swim meet

Twenty-five High School Swim teams competed at the Southern Arizona Regional Qualifier Swim Meet in Oro Valley on Oct. 28-29. It was the final opportunity for the teams from Southern Arizona to achieve qualifying times for the State Championship Meet this weekend. San Manuel High School had one of the smaller teams at the meet (and represented one of the smaller schools) but they packed a powerful punch.

The preliminary session was held on Friday. The goal in prelims is to advance to the finals, and for the most part that's just what the Miners did. Darien Apuron swam a 1:03.85 in the Girls 100 Butterfly Championship Finals to set a new school record and finish 3rd overall.




