Vote Your Values, Fight for Your Rights

How does voting in every election affect you, from midterm to general? The people you elect up and down the ballot make decisions that impact your civil rights and quality of life.

Every vote counts. Choose wisely. The people you elect will be around for a long time. Decide if you want to vote for candidates who believe in American Democracy, those who are dedicated to making life better for ordinary Americans regardless of the color of their skin, where they came from, or what they believe.

Or you could choose those who do not believe in your right to vote unless you vote for them. They prefer an authoritarian form of government. If you think the government has too much control already, what do you think authoritarian leaders will do? They seek power and money. They do not care about

the people they serve. It's all about what they can gain by being in office. Large corporations and the wealthy 20% will benefit far more than ordinary working citizens. One only needs to look back at history to see that this is true.

The Governor can sign into law or block legislation that offers protections and equal access to services for people in their state. Choose one who believes that everyone's vote counts, one who tells the truth, does not amplify big lies, and cares more about helping the people she will serve than taking away their rights.

The Secretary of State is Arizona's chief elections officer responsible for administering elections and can expand or limit your voting access through various policies. Choose one who is honest, one who believes in democracy, and one who will protect your right to vote. If you vote for a candidate who believes violence is a solution to addressing problems and believes that overturning an election is the best way to get a desired outcome, you can be sure your votes may not count in the future.

In Pinal County, Supreme Court judges and Superior Court judges are appointed by the Governor. State courts make decisions that affect you, like whether reproductive freedoms are protected or not. Before you mark all the boxes with a yes or no, find out if any of the judges have poor ratings and make your decisions based on that.

How do you feel about your children's right to learn? Local school boards can make rules that restrict discussions about race and gender, or they can uphold the rights of students and educators to teach and learn about these issues. Elect school board candidates who want children to learn about their world

and who will not try to limit what they can and can't know.

Ballot propositions give voters a chance to be heard on issues that are important to them. Be sure to take the time to read up on each of them before you choose yes or no. Some will take away your rights and leave choices in the hands of politicians, not the people.

Each choice you make will affect your future in Arizona. Please choose wisely.

The Projects To End
Pinal County Gridlock

As a business owner and former President of Pinal Partnership, which was formed to increase economic development opportunities and our quality of life, I have not only witnessed Pinal County's rapid growth but also the lingering traffic problems that need attention now. We just can't wait any longer.

Without the new roads and freeways funded by Proposition 469, our traffic will go from really bad to worse, job creators will look elsewhere, and first responders will get stuck in traffic.

The new infrastructure will help lure new companies to the area creating more local jobs so fewer residents will have to commute. The projects include the "Casa Grande Connector" project that involves four lanes from the City of Casa Grande, to the future alignment of the North-South Corridor Parkway to the East, located in the City of Coolidge. This system allows residents to travel north to south and east to west in Pinal County without the gridlock.

This transportation plan was written so that every part of Pinal County benefits. There is also a long list of projects designed to keep traffic moving in every community in Pinal County, as well as funding for dial-a-ride services which helps seniors and the disabled.

As the owner of Windmill Winery in Florence, I feel this infrastructure will help local businesses attract more customers as well as move goods and services. It will sure make it easier to get to my business just as it will for thousands of others in Pinal County.

The transportation plan and its funding were approved by Pinal County voters in 2017. Unfortunately, Phoenix special interests convinced the Arizona Supreme Court to rescind the funding earlier this year, while leaving the transportation plan in place. Prop 469 simply reauthorizes the funds. It is not a tax hike. And it is modeled after the way other counties in Arizona fund critical new roads and freeways.

Now is the time to finally end the gridlock and begin a new era for Pinal County. Please vote yes on Proposition 469.



CASA of Arizona celebrates National Adoption Day with hundreds of adoptions this year; More CASA advocates are needed to help pave the way for children to find loving homes in times of crisis

With adoptions taking place across the country for National Adoption Day in November, CASA of Arizona (Court Appointed Special Advocates) will celebrate this milestone with hundreds of children across the state that have now found their forever, loving homes this year.

National Adoption Day is a collective effort to raise awareness of the more than 115,000 children waiting to be adopted from foster care in the United States. Each November, children across the country get to celebrate a new life with loving families. In many of these cases, a CASA advocate has been there to support the child along the way.

On any given day, there are more than 11,500 children and youth in Arizona living in foster homes, group homes, shelters, or with relatives due to neglect and abuse. At present, more than 10,000 of these children don't have access to a CASA volunteer to advocate for their best interest.

A family in Arizona recently experienced the gift of adoption as they formally adopted a seven-year-old boy and four-year-old girl whom they had fostered since the youngest was seven months old. The day coincided with the girl's four-year birthday and the family threw a neighborhood party for everyone that had been involved to celebrate this new sense of security that their son described with these words: "I belong now. This is my family."

"This is a new start for these children," said the adopted father and mother in this case – Joe and Christina. "Seeing the kids get something good in their life and finally finding a life full of love provides such a sense of relief and happiness for us all – and we couldn't have gotten to this point without CASA."

CASA volunteers are everyday members of the community who are appointed by a judge to represent the best interest of abused and neglected children during a dependency case. Their role is to act as a consistent adult presence for a child

in foster care as they go through court proceedings and adjust to life in their temporary homes – to walk the walk with the child and let them know they're not alone.

"CASAs are desperately needed because they advocate for each child's best interest above anything else," said Joe and Christina. "The minute our CASA volunteer was appointed, we felt a positive shift in the case with progress being made to establish stability and permanency in the children's lives. Our CASA volunteer provided us with the miracle these children so desperately needed."

CASA volunteers have the unique opportunity to make a huge, direct impact in the lives of children – while also becoming integral parts of the CASA program, court process and family's lives. "If you're looking for an opportunity to change someone's life and set them on a completely different life path, becoming a CASA is for you," said CASA volunteer Al who has been with the program for 9 years. "For me, the idea that I've put these kids into a home where I know they will be loved and cared for – and if they get a boo-boo, mom and dad will put a band-aid on it – is irreplaceable. I can make time for that any day."

CASA of Arizona is seeking volunteers to fill the caseload gap in the state, including all 15 Arizona counties. Further, CASA of Arizona is seeking to increase the diversity and demographics of its volunteers. Volunteers with CASA of Arizona do not need any prior special training and can come from all walks of life. Anyone 21 years of age or older, who can pass a thorough background check and complete required training, is encouraged to apply. Another way to get involved is a program with similar requirements called the Foster Care Review Board (FCRB) in which volunteers are appointed by the Court to a 5-member panel that meets 1 weekday


