### Men arrested by SPD, SWAT at Arboretum

Pinal County Sheriff's Office and Pinal County Regional SWAT were called in to help law enforcement officers from the Superior Police Department when a suspect in a suspicious activity report barricaded himself at the Boyce Thompson Arboretum.

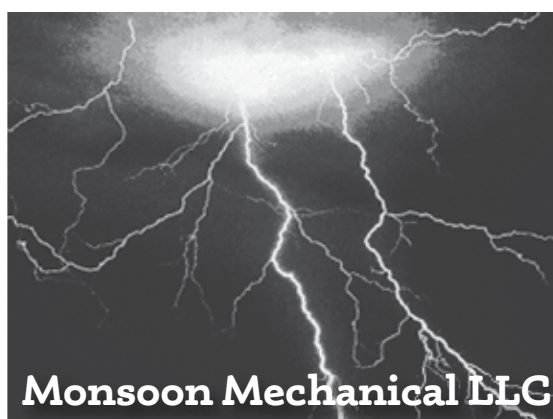
Superior Police responded to the suspicious activity report on Thursday, Oct. 28, at 6:20 a.m. Upon arrival, officers immediately arrested two suspects, Charles Fee, 36, and Jamie Mansfield, 28. A third suspect ran off into the park.

Superior PD requested assistance from PCSO and SWAT. Shortly before noon, the third suspect, Clayton Thornburg, 35, was taken into custody. He was transported to the hospital for a medical evaluation.

All three men were charged with burglary, criminal damage and theft; they have all been booked into the Pinal County Jail in Florence.

There were no injuries to law enforcement.

"SPD would like to thank our partnering law enforcement agencies for their assistance and in helping us keep our community safe," a press release from the Superior Police Department said.

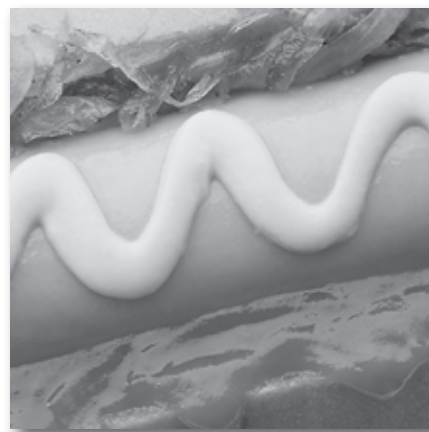
### 14 Knights of Columbus Flag Retirement
