



## Hayden's season ends at semi-finals

The Hayden football team competed in the 1A state playoff semifinals on Nov. 4, against Williams at Coronado High School.

On offensive, Quarterback Fabian Elvira went 20 for 49 with 344 yards passing, 3 passing touchdowns, 3 interceptions, and 3 rushes for 10 yards. Brandon Garner Jr. had 6 catches and 143 yards receiving and 2 touchdowns. Isaac Castillo had 7 catches with 127 yards of receiving with 1 touchdown, Deondre Collier had 6 catches,

70 yards and 8 rushes for 39 yards and 2 fumbles. Moraes Cruz had 5 rushes for 14 yards, 1 fumble and 1 catch for 4 yards.

On defense, Rene Ochoa had 8 tackles, 1 assist, and 1 forced fumble. Mark Acevedo had 7 tackles and 3 assists. Julian Cruz had 6 tackles and 1 assist, Brandon Garner Jr. had 5 tackles and 1 assist, Deondre Collier had 4 tackles, 3 assists, and 1 fumble recovery for 22-yard touchdown. Moraes Cruz had 3 tackles and 2 assists. Andrew Waddell 3 tackles and 1 assist, Dominic Alvarado had 2 tackles and 1 assist. JJ Aguirre had 2 tackles, Keyston Pool had 2

tackles and 2 sacks, Izzy Gallego and Matthew Armenta had 1 tackle each.

The game ended in Williams's favor, with a final score of, 38-56.

"We came out short Friday night. To sum things up, we played our worst game of the season. Not taking anything away from Williams, they were the better team that night and played tough," head coach John Estrada began. "Our boys played tough and played their hearts out. I'm very proud of what they accomplished this year. One game does not define what these boys accomplished all year. I have the utmost respect for our team and especially the seniors. Such a humble group of kids. I'll miss their football knowledge, their personalities, their hard work ethic, leadership, and watching them on the field play-

ing football.

It was an honor to coach you guys. To the underclassmen, next year's season starts now. The weight room is the key."

The Lobos ended their season with a 9-1 record.


