



Police action ends school athletic practices early

Last Wednesday night, athletes practicing for upcoming meets and games in San Manuel had more excitement than just playing and practicing usually causes.

Staff members reported hearing gunshots in the vicinity of the school.

Immediately, Pinal County Sheriff's Office was notified and the game was ended early and athletes sent home.

Deputies, with help from Arizona Department of Public Safety's helicopter, K-9s and other law enforcement agencies, spent several hours clearing the school and making sure that students would be safe

upon their return to school the next day.

PCSO Public Information Officer Lauren Reimer told the *San Manuel Miner*, "The desert area behind the school is often frequented by target shooters and desert partiers who sometimes discharge fireworks and firearms. The original callers advised the sounds were coming from the general area. During our search, no evidence of fireworks or casings were found at the school."

Mammoth-San Manuel School District Athletic Director Damon Lovato said no games were affected by the incident.


CBD: What Is It?

A recent phenomenon has caught the nation's attention. After years of repression, a medicinal herb has been elevated to folk hero status. CBD is currently enjoying wide spread acceptance and praise for its effectiveness in managing pain and seizures, as well as being carried by sheer momentum from its former repressed, demonized status to that of panacea for most health issues. Stands are popping up on every corner. Wall Street has taken notice. The legal system has even softened its contrived stance against CBD's mother plant, marijuana.

As with any herb (plant), marijuana contains constituents (ingredients) that can be useful to living creatures. Cannabidiol (CBD) is one of the 100 different cannabinoid constituents of the herb marijuana, cannabis sativa. Its molecular structure fits perfectly, as do internal cannabinoids produced in the brain itself, onto receptor sites in the body that control pain and seizures, that of CB1 and CB2.

These cannabinoid receptors, located throughout the body, are part of the endocannabinoid system which is involved in a variety of physiological processes including appetite, pain-sensation, mood, and memory.

Of the 100 different cannabinoids found in marijuana, the two that garner most of the attention are CBD and THC. THC (delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol) is the constituent that produces the altered mental states. As with any substance that has mind altering properties associated with it, marijuana is controversial. In this country there are only three non-pharmaceutical mind altering drugs that are available legally; alcohol, nicotine and caffeine. Caffeine is the only one without age constraints for its use and it is often combined

with large amounts of sugar giving it a high potential as a health risk.

CBD has become such a phenomenon that commercial enterprises have begun to isolate it from the whole plant (though there is certainly synergistic value with whole plant use) and market it as one would a drug (a molecule that has been isolated and concentrated from a plant and/or synthesized to qualify for a patent). Because it is still a "natural" substance, CBD can not be easily patented and therefore remains available for anyone to market. And, because it has been isolated from the THC, it has been allowed the status of "non-controlled substance."

The marketers have packaged this useful herbal substance in many forms. It can exist in an almost pure form of 99.9% CBD. It can be offered in pills, patches, creams and gels. It can be mixed and matched with many different substances. And, of course, it can

Christmas Tree Safety and Other Tips

With the holidays fast approaching, the National Fire Protection Association, the Oracle Fire District and the Oracle Firewise Board would like to remind you to practice safety as you select a tree and decorate your home. Here are some tips.

Christmas Tree Safety:

- Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when shaken.
- Cut 2" off the bottom of the tree before placing it in a stand.
- Keep it at least three feet away from fireplaces, candles, vents or any other heat source.
- Do not place it in front of an exit.
- Add water daily to the tree stand!
- Only use lights that have a label identifying it for indoor use and do not use string of lights that are worn or there are broken cords or loose bulb connections.
- Never use candles on a tree.
- Always turn off the lights before leaving home or going to bed.

Other Safety tips include:

- Test your smoke alarms.
- Keep children and pets away from candles.



Combatting blight: properties to be auctioned

Since 2016 the Superior Town Council has taken a proactive approach to eliminating blight and securing abandoned properties. The Council allocated budget funds to begin a clean and lien program that legally allows the Town to clean and secure the abandoned properties then place a lien on the property. The two properties that the Town has tackled in 2019 will be sold at a Pinal County Sheriff's Auction

on Dec. 19, 2019:

Both properties have a minimum bid to recover the cost of abatement, AHCCCS and tax liens, and foreclosure, but if the minimum bid is met then they will be transferred with a clean title to a new owner who will hopefully give them the care they need and deserve.

Affectionately called the Copper Corridor Blight Busters, the Mayors of Globe, Miami, Hayden Kearny, Superior have teamed up Gila County to apply for an Environmental Protection Agency regional Brownfields Grant. If awarded, the Brownfields funding can be used for environmental assessments of

properties and in some cases funding can be used to make necessary environmental repairs. Gila County and the Town of Superior have used Brownfields funding to demolish problem properties and in the case of the Belmont Hotel the funding was used to complete environmental remediations.

In addition to applying for the grant, the Town of Superior took the lead on working with the League of Arizona Cities and Towns to develop statewide policy and legislation to allow cities and towns to create a vacant building registry ordinance. In August, the Town presented a resolution to the members of the League to allow for the League to develop the legislation. The long term goal is to eventually close the loop holes in tax law that incentives blight.
