

Arizona Mining Association awards Resolution Copper 2022 SPADE Award

Superior, AZ - The Arizona Mining Association (AMA) awarded Resolution Copper the 2022 Sustainability, Preservation, and Diversity

in the Environment Award (SPADE) for Public Education. The prestigious award recognizes mining companies that have led,

financed, or hosted public education efforts for habitat preservation and enhancement or species protection and restoration.

“Over the past several years, AMA members have increased their efforts in safety practices and environmental protection, thereby raising the standard for SPADE excellence,” stated Steve Trussell, Arizona Mining Association Executive Director. “AMA is honored to present the SPADE award to Resolution Copper for their partnership with the US Forest Service, NAU and Western Apache Tribes in restoring the Emory Oak that will nourish Native American Communities for future generations.”

Resolution Copper began a multiyear partnership with the Tonto and Coconino National Forests



(TNF and CNF), Northern Arizona University (NAU), and Apache Tribes in Arizona to create the Emory Oak Collaborative Tribal Restoration Initiative in response to concerns voiced by Western Apache Tribal elders that the health of Emory Oak groves is declining, with fewer and fewer acorns produced each year across Arizona.

The Emory Oak is a culturally significant tree to the Western Apache people. The acorns provide a traditional food source and in addition to other cultural and ceremonial uses. In recent years, drought, fire suppression, livestock over-grazing, species competition, and climate change have circumvented the growth of new Emory Oak seedlings and the production of acorns. The Emory Oak project partners with the Yavapai-Apache Nation, Tonto Apache Tribe, and White Mountain Apache Tribe (WMAT), with assistance from San Carlos Apache tribal elders, to research the protection and

restoration of Emory Oak groves across Arizona. A fundamental component of the program involves transferring traditional ecological knowledge from elders to youth through education and collaboration. The Emory Oak project has sponsored multiple public education efforts, from planting Emory Oak saplings to training, outreach, and developing research papers and presentations. The program also aims to create a record of the traditional ecological knowledge used to manage the Emory Oak ecosystems so younger generations can access it in the years ahead.

“We are grateful for the collaborative partnership between the US Forest Service, NAU and Western Apache Tribal elders. Indigenous Traditional Ecological Knowledge has guided every aspect of this work from identifying priority Emory Oak Groves to implementing best practices on the ground to preserve a critical aspect of Western Apache

ADOT's high country advisory: 'Know Snow' for winter driving

PHOENIX – With winter storms occurring in northern Arizona and the high desert this month and more anticipated in the coming months, the Arizona Department of Transportation is reminding drivers to be prepared if traveling on state highways that could be affected by snow and ice.

ADOT crews continue to maintain and operate the agency's statewide fleet of 200 snowplows in areas where they are needed.

It's also important for drivers to equip themselves and their vehicles for winter driving conditions.

ADOT offers safety tips at azdot.gov/KnowSnow. Drivers should be prepared to slow down on potentially slippery highways, while also leaving extra room behind the vehicle ahead. Other recommendations include having a fully charged cellphone and packing emergency prep items such as additional warm clothing, blankets, food and water and first aid kit. Check your vehicle before heading out in winter weather, making sure – at a minimum – that the tires, heater and windshield wipers are in good shape.

Before traveling, research weather conditions to determine whether it would be better to wait for the storm to pass so ADOT's nearly 200 snowplows can clear the highways. Check road conditions by calling 511 or visiting az511.gov. ADOT's Twitter account (@ArizonaDOT) and Facebook page ([facebook.com/AZDOT](https://www.facebook.com/AZDOT)) provide real-time information and interaction.

While ADOT's snowplow operators are ready to help you, you should help them in return. Always respect the plow. Avoid passing a snowplow that's clearing a highway until the driver pulls over to let traffic pass, and never assume a snowplow operator knows your vehicle is nearby. If you can't see the plow driver, there's a good chance the driver can't see you.

Remember: The safest place on a highway when it's snowing is trailing a safe distance behind a snowplow.

The boys also competed at Safford and took tenth place as a team.





The Miners have their last home match on Wednesday, Dec. 14, with a start time of 3 p.m. Come out and support the Miner wrestling program!






