



he holiday tradition of children writing letters to Santa Claus at Christmas is more than 150 years old. The first Santa letters were actually from St. Nicholas to children, counseling them on their behavior. The first images of St. Nicholas were of him as a disciplinarian wearing his clerical garb and complete with a birch switch in hand to use on a wayward child. Parents wrote the letters to admonish their kids and motivate them to adjust their behavior. The letters were left in or by the children's Christmas stockings. Soon the children responded with their own letters to St. Nick letting him know



that they were good.

As the images of St. Nicholas grew into the Santa Claus we know today, so did the tradition of children sending letters to Santa. During the Civil War, the price of postage was lowered and postal service improved. An image by popular cartoonist Thomas Nast of *Harpers Weekly* showed Santa sitting at a desk with two piles of letters one for naughty children and one for the good children. This helped promote the idea of sending letters to Santa. Nast is also credited with the idea that Santa Claus lived at the North Pole with an 1866 illustration with Santa's address as Santaclausville, N.P. This gave kids a destination to send their letters and soon post offices around the country began receiving letters to Santa.

The post offices sent back letters or placed them in the dead letter office where they were later destroyed. Newspapers began printing the letters and soon requested kids send letters directly to them even offering prizes for the best letters. Charitable organizations requested that the post office send them the letters so they could help those kids in need get a Christmas present.

Here are some letters from 100 years ago. You can see the toys have changed over the years as well as some of the requested items but kids are still kids. Merry Christmas, everyone!

Dear Santa ...

Christmas is coming. It will be here ever so soon. In every land, every country, every city or town or village - really, anyplace you can find on a map and many places that you cannot - children have written their holiday missives, expressing their heart's desires and are anxiously awaiting a Christmas visit from Santa.

The United States Postal Service site states, "Each year, hundreds of thousands of letters sent to Santa from children and families arrive at Post Offices around the country. Most letters ask for toys and games. Some ask for basic necessities. Some ask for help for themselves and their loved ones."

For as long as children have been sending letters to Santa, he has cherished these communications and shared them with his wife. In December of 1899, Santa decided to share a letter to be printed in a newspaper. The letter was quite simple. In it an unnamed girl said, "Dear Santa, If you haven't time to pick out things for me, just leave everything you've got."

The very next year, many more letters to Santa were printed in the same newspaper. A tradition was born. Though Santa has never explained the reason he started sharing the letters he receives and allows them to be printed, there are many theories which he has equally never denied as possibilities.

The chief theory is that with the increased population of the world, Santa was using this method of communication to seek out new helpers.

Another theory, somewhat less likely to apply in all situations, is that the newspaper editor had been a very good boy or girl in their youth and Santa felt they deserved an extra present.





An illuminated vehicle parade of ATVs, classic cars, and oh so many more gathered in front of Peppersauce Motorsports & Rentals and, as






Luke looked right at him, and asked bluntly, "Santa, why do You say 'Ho-Ho-Ho' so much?"





To the Real Santa:



Copper Area News is committed to providing our readers with as much information as possible. This graph shows the positive cases as of press time on December 22, 2020. We have also included a graph showing the daily counts for the past week. Daily statewide case counts are recording higher than they were during the last peak this Summer and hospitals are becoming overwhelmed by COVID-19 patients.

There are a few points we would like our readers to consider when following this data.

- 1. This will continue to be a rolling total of positive cases. It does not reflect recoveries or deaths. The Arizona Department of Health Services does not break out this data.
- 2. If you see a reduction in numbers from day to day it is most likely due to a data entry error or mis-coding of a zip code (at the state level).
- 3. This is all zip code based data; most of our zip codes include unincorporated areas. There is no way to track exactly which areas each of the positive cases are. Example, Kearny and Winkelman each have small communities in their zip code that are not in the Town's incorporated boundaries.
- 4. If you live in Gila County, please follow the Gila County Health and Emergency Management, Facebook. They have maintained their data on recoveries and current positive cases.
- 5. You can follow other data such as ICU bed use, Ventilator use and hospital capacity online: https://bit. ly/3inh280
