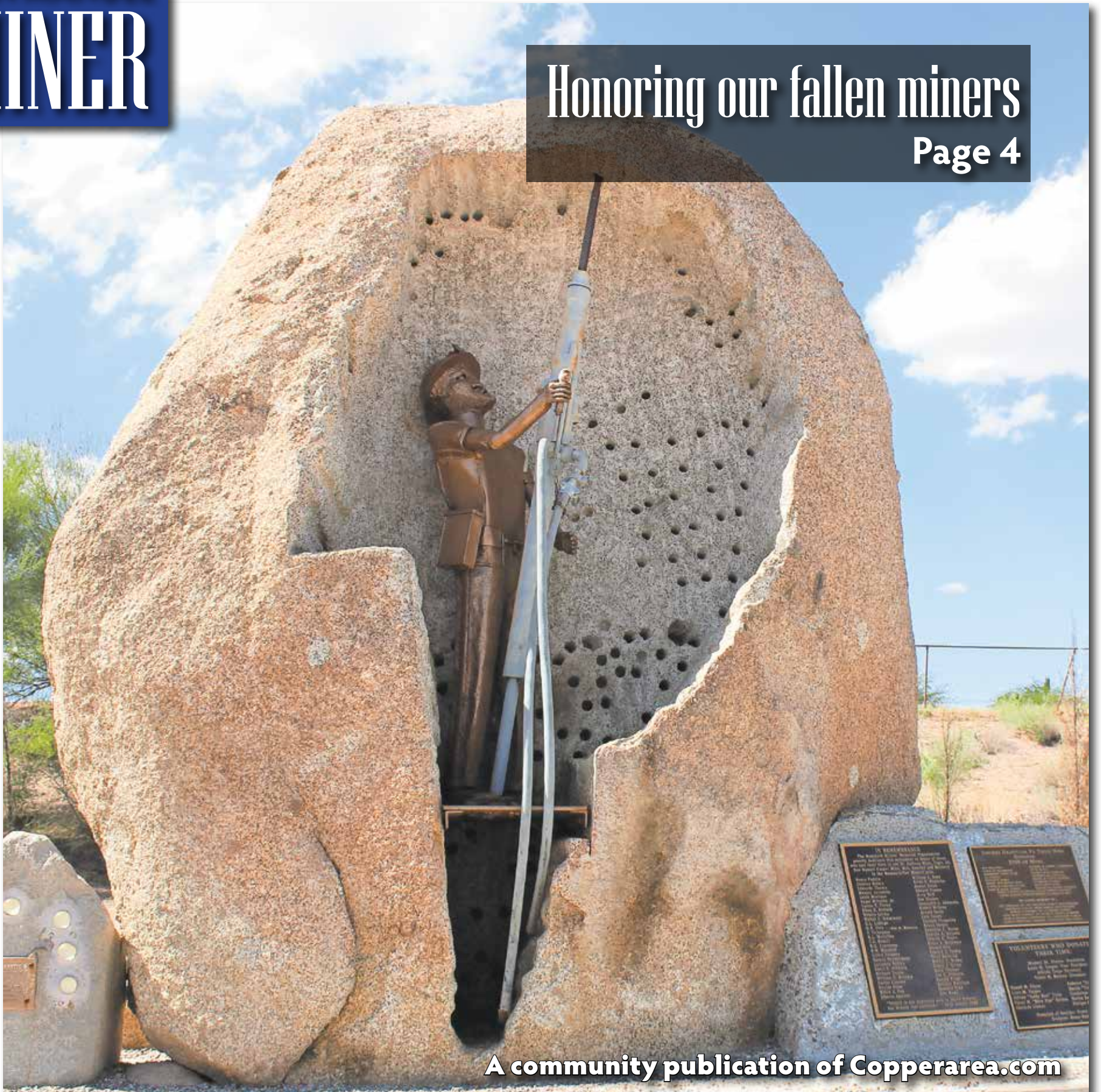
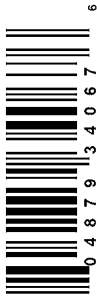

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Delays continue on State Route 77 in Winkelman

Motorists who use the Gila River Bridge on State Route 77 in Winkelman will continue to experience intermittent delays, while bridge girders are placed on the west side of the new bridge.

Remembering a Pearl Harbor Sailor

December 7, 2020 was celebrated as the 79th Anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor in the Territory of Hawaii.

December 7, 1941 was “a day that will live in infamy” as President Franklin Delano Roosevelt stated. That day the United States was drawn into World War II. The brazen attack by the Japanese Navy resulted in the loss of 2,403 Americans including 68 civilians. Of those killed, 2008 were Navy personnel, 218 were members of the Army and 109 were

Marines.

One of the sailors who survived that day was Doris “Dorie” Miller. On that morning, Dorie was a Messman Third Class, on the battleship USS West Virginia. A Messman was one of the few positions that African Americans could hold in the Navy which was segregated at the time. He was performing his duties gathering laundry when the Japanese attack began. When Dorie was summoned to his battle station, he found that the anti-aircraft battery had been destroyed by an enemy torpedo. He

then went looking for something else to do.

A Lieutenant Commander Johnson noted his stature. Miller, the Heavyweight Boxing Champion of the ship, was over 6 feet tall and weighed over 200 pounds. Lt. Commander Johnson ordered Miller to assist in moving their commanding officer, Captain Bennion. Miller moved the Captain to a safer position then went looking to help other sailors. He ran into two officers and although untrained in its use, manned a .50 caliber anti-aircraft gun. He fired the gun at attacking Japanese planes until he ran out of ammunition. Miller then began helping more wounded to safety. He fought through oil and water to bring wounded sailors to safer positions where they could get medical help, thus saving lives. For his actions that morning, he would be awarded the Navy Cross for Valor, the Navy’s 2nd highest military honor. He became the first African American to earn this honor and also became one of the first American heroes of World War II.

Doris Miller was born in Waco, Texas on Oct. 12, 1919. He was named Doris because



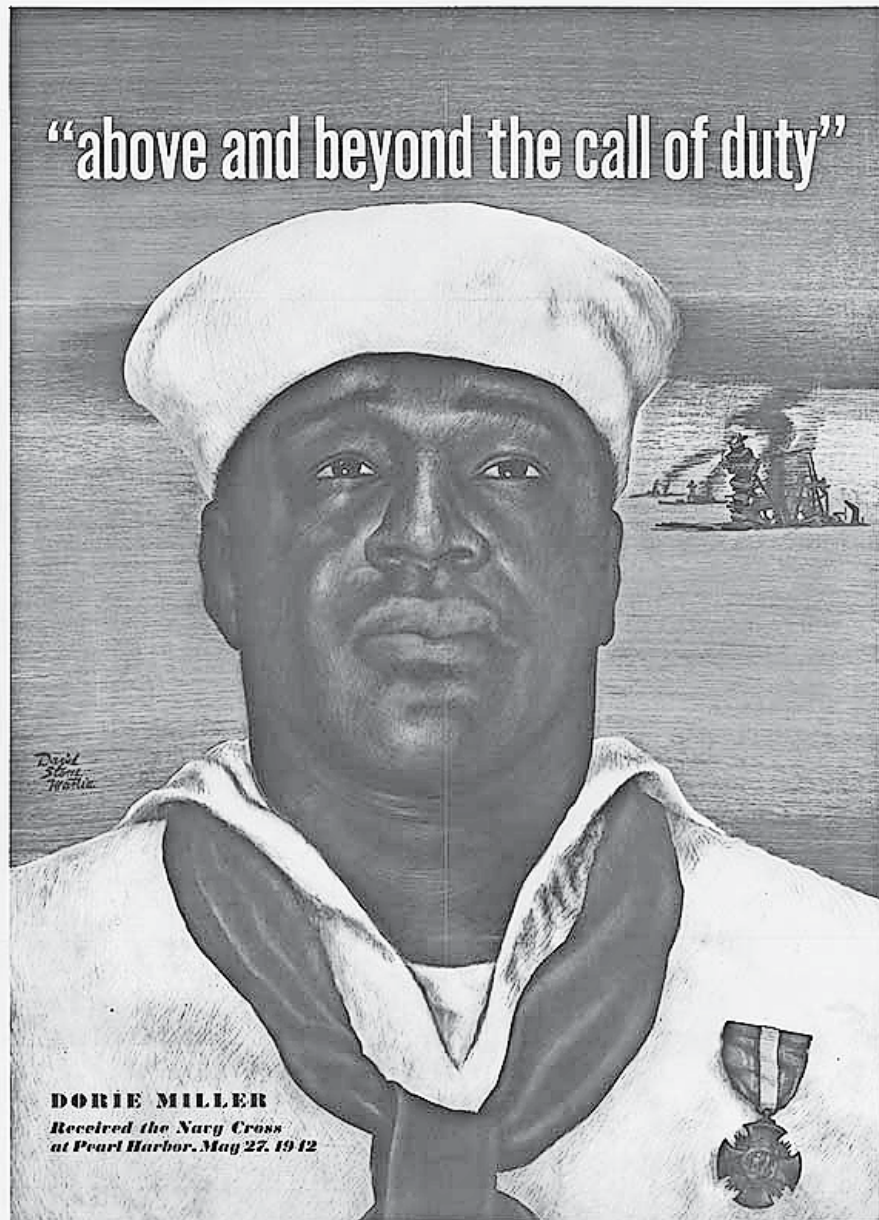

the midwife who delivered him was sure the baby would be a female. His father was a share crop farmer. Doris quit school in the 8th grade and helped his family work the farm. In 1939, he enlisted in the Navy to help his family financially and to see the world.

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the attack at Pearl Harbor, Doris was ordered to travel in the United States on a war bond tour. Newspapers

throughout the states had covered his story and he became somewhat of a celebrity, especially among

African Americans. His likeness appeared on recruiting posters and propaganda posters used to

sell war bonds.

In 1943, he returned to active duty and was assigned to the carrier escort ship Liscome Bay. He had been promoted to Cook Third Class. On Nov. 24, 1943, the Liscome Bay, while engaged in the Battle of Makin, was struck by a torpedo from a Japanese submarine. The bomb magazine exploded killing more than 600 men including Doris Miller. Of the 900 men on board, only 272 survived.

We honor all of those soldiers who lived and died at Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. We remember. Thank you for your service and sacrifice.

Copper Area News is committed to providing our readers with as much information as possible. This graph shows the positive cases as of press time on Dec. 8, 2020 we have also included a graph showing the daily counts for the past week. Daily statewide case counts are recording higher than they were during the last peak this Summer.

There are a few points we would like our readers to consider when following this data.

1. This will continue to be a rolling total of positive cases. It does not reflect recoveries or deaths. The Arizona Department of Health Services does not break out this data.
2. If you see a reduction in numbers from day to day it is most likely due to a data entry error or mis-coding of a zip code (at the state level).
3. This is all zip code based data; most of our zip codes include unincorporated areas. There is no way to track exactly which areas each of the positive cases are. Example, Kearny and Winkelman each have small communities in their zip code that are not in the Town's incorporated boundaries.
4. If you live in Gila County, please follow the Gila County Health and Emergency Management, Facebook. They have maintained their data on recoveries and current positive cases.
