Changes coming to the way MVD issues plates, tabs and documents; customers to get items through U.S. Mail

PHOENIX – The new year will usher in a new way for Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division customers to get license plates, registration tabs and many documents such as vehicle titles.

Beginning in January, customers will receive these items through the U.S. Mail and will no longer be able to obtain them at an MVD or Authorized Third Party office. Customers should make sure their address is current and complete with the U.S. Postal Service and MVD.

"The MVD needs to be well-positioned for the growth of e-commerce," said MVD Stakeholder Relations Manager Jennifer Bowser Richards. "Distributing items such as license plates, tabs, title work and other documents allows us to prepare for the growing demand for fulfilling customer orders through the mail as MVD continues to increase the number of services available online, anytime."

All registration documents and license plate tabs, including those issued today at MVD self-service kiosks will be mailed. When customers renew, their record is updated instantly and a receipt will be proof of registration.

For customers getting a license plate, the change will also mean the plate number will be entered into the customer's service file and the temporary plate issued at the office will have the same number as the permanent plate being mailed.

Customers who purchase Off-Highway Vehicle decals the same day they plan to use them at a recreational area will not receive the decal at the office, but will get a receipt that should be kept with them to prove the decals have been purchased.

In the future, more vehicle titles will transition to an electronic process. Currently, a limited number of title transfers such as one-owner to one-owner transfers of Arizona-registered vehicles can already be done entirely online through AZ MVD Now, which is available through ServiceArizona.com.

Death of Oracle man remains under investigation

The mid-November death of Oracle man Tommy Witcher remains under investigation by Pinal County Sheriff's Office, although not as a suspicious death.

Pinal County Sheriff's Office Public Information Officer Lauren Reimer told the San Manuel Miner that Witcher's death is under investigation as a drug

overdose.

Despite rumors of a possible fight or assault, Reimer said that there was "no trauma" involved in Witcher's death and it has not been deemed a homicide.

The Medical Examiner has yet to make his final ruling and issue the death certificate.

Mammoth Police Report

According to state law, there are two methods by which police may arrest suspected offenders. The suspect may be physically taken into the department and booked into jail, or the arresting officer may write a citation and release the suspect to appear in court later. All suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. Only criminal citations are listed. All damages are estimates.

Joey Sanchez, 34, was arrested and charged with assault-DV (domestic violence) and disorderly conduct, as well as two warrants issued out of Mammoth. He was transported and booked into the Pinal County Jail in Florence.

Midseason report: past, present and future of Copper Area Basketball Teams

As most, if not all, Copper Area high school basketball teams and players enjoy a break in the schedule and from classes, let's take a look how the teams and players have fared at what can be considered the season's midpoint.

MEN'S BASKETBALL

Hayden Lobos

Record (Overall, Region): 2-10, 1-5

Next game: Jan. 7, 2020 at Baboquivari

Notes: The Lobos season so far has been one of streaks, unfortunately, two losing streaks sandwiched around a modest two-game winning streak. After starting the season with six-straight losses, the Lobos defeated Ray (65 – 48) and Immaculate

Heart (53 – 48) before losing four-straight, including a 59 – 50 defeat at Globe in the Copper Cities Tournament on Dec. 27.

Ray Bearcats

Record: 1-11, 0-5

Next game: Jan. 9, 2020 at Leading Edge Academy

Notes: The Cats lone win to this point of their schedule was on Dec. 2, a 59 – 50 victory against Immaculate Heart. They've dropped seven-straight games since, including a 49 – 46 loss at Superior in one of their final games before the break.

Next game: Jan. 7, 2020 vs Miami

Notes: The Miners have shown to be a legitimate state title contender, finishing as the runner-up in the preseason Boyd

Baker Tournament. As a matter of fact, the only team to beat the Miners so far has been St. Augustine Catholic, which it did in consecutive games, including the championship game of the Boyd Baker Tournament. Since those losses, the Miners have won five-straight games, including a couple of lopsided victories against Santa Rita (64 – 37) and Globe (78 – 48) before the break.

Three players are averaging more than 10 PPG – Javy Tamayo, Jose Moreno and Caleb Quintero.
