Is there a remedy? I don't know. Recycling is a small-margin business these

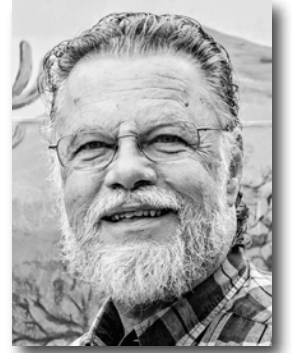
days. I will do my best to find out.

Kearny church welcomes new pastor

Love is the motive that drives Roger Pike, the new Pastor of Kearny Southern Baptist Church – his love for all of God’s children, regardless of their religious beliefs or lack thereof, and the love for his Savior and Lord.

“We are all God’s children and we are told to love each other unconditionally. The same way God loves us,” he said. “We have to accept people where they are, love them and help them meet their needs. We have to show others the love and ways of Jesus by how we live our lives and how we treat other people on a daily basis.”

That’s what he plans to do in Kearny.

While Kearny Southern Baptist is a very small congregation, “it will grow,” he said. “But it will take baby steps,” not giant steps as God leads Pastor Pike and his congregation forward to tell people about Jesus.

The soft-spoken pastor with his North Carolina accent and sense of humor has already had a positive effect on the church as he preaches from the Bible, relating God’s words to everyday living in a manner that shows how to make obedience to God the cornerstone of living.

Pastor Pike and his wife, Joyce, have pastored in small churches over the years including Payson, Welton, Safford and Eloy., as well as larger churches in Tucson They were married in Mars Hill, North Carolina after high school graduation in

1968.

He then served four years in the Marine Corps, seeing a lot of the world and the United States. Though he had orders for Vietnam more than once, they were always cancelled before he got there. “I spent more time out of country than in country,” he remarked, but his typing skills earned him an administrative assignment. “I did go to Vietnam once, but I was there only long enough to unload supplies and leave.”

During his pastoring, he also spent time traveling to many Arizona high schools, including those in the Copper Basin area, as a basketball referee and a baseball umpire. He also holds a permanent substitute teacher certificate. But wherever he goes, he always shows and teaches about the love of Jesus for those God created.

He has coached some football and that is game he prefers to watch. “When I watch baseball or basketball, I’m always watching the officials, not the game!” he said with a grin.

He is a 1978 graduate of Grand Canyon University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Religion and has also attended Mars Hill College, Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas, and has an honorary doctorate degree from American Bible College and Seminary in Bethany, Oklahoma.

Pastor Pike has also completed special training in leadership and evangelism. He felt called to preach in 1968 after he married, was licensed in North Carolina in 1968 and was ordained in 1976 by East Mesa Baptist church.

Joyce says she always felt called to be a pastor’s wife. She enjoys quilting crocheting and taking care of grandbabies as hobbies.

The couple has three grown children, a daughter in Tucson, a

daughter in California, and a son in Tempe.

Her church experience has included many Sunday School positions from teacher to director as well as many leadership positions dealing with missions and women’s groups.

Sunday School begins at 9:30 Sunday morning followed by Worship Services at 11 a.m. and 6 p.m. Members also get together for potlucks about once a month to share and visit.

If those participating own more than one residence they can only obtain vouchers for the primary residence. Vouchers can be used at the Oracle Transfer Station and are good for a truck load of up to 750 lbs. or the Dudleyville Landfill and are good for a truck load of up to three cubic yards. Vouchers will be issued according to the name that appears on the utility bill and that person must be present when redeeming the vouchers at the Oracle Transfer Station or Dudleyville Landfill.
