

SUPERIOR, ARIZ. – Over the weekend of Jan. 29-30, 2022, the Superior Chamber of Commerce will present its 14th Annual Home and Building Tour, as well as a free antique show held at the recently restored Magma Club. A popular event among locals and visitors alike, the Home and Building Tour will showcase Superior's unique, historic architecture, with highlights ranging from completely renovated homes and buildings that many would have bulldozed to a "falling down" motel that sat vacant and unloved for many years, but has recently been converted to lovely single apartments. In addition, the activity-packed weekend will feature live music, guided hikes, a pancake breakfast, handmade pottery for sale from the Mexican village of Mata Ortiz and historian speakers who will bring the former mining town's past to life. The self-guided Home and Building Tour, which begins at the Chamber of Commerce office at 165 W. Main Street, will run from 9 a.m.

to 5 p.m. on Saturday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday.

With a history dating back to 1875, Superior has undergone an amazing resurgence in recent years that has included efforts to give new life to the town's older buildings. Tour attendees will be able to explore some of these structures, such as a home built in 1929 with its beautiful architectural details preserved, including the original doors with glass doorknobs. While visiting the homes on the Tour, attendees may even glean some decorative inspiration for their own properties, as several of the current owners have added interesting features to the homes and yards!

Another highlight is one of the town's few adobe buildings still standing: the Alvy Building, a two-story structure built in 1930 that housed the Knights of Columbus meetings for many years. It has since been renovated into apartments with incredible views. The Town of Superior is excited

to announce that it has purchased the original Superior High School and will become the Town's multi-generational facility. Once renovations are complete, the complex will feature the Town Hall operations; wellness spaces such a dance room, gym and work out facility; the

Senior Center and Library. The multi-gen facility also will house the Superior Enterprise Center which will be a hub for job training and entrepreneurship development. The original Superior High School will become a hub for all things Superior, and this historic and important

building will once again be accessible to the public. To celebrate the official purchase, the High School will be on the Superior Chamber of Commerce annual home tour. The Town will be maintaining the structure of the building, only slightly modifying some aspects of the building to allow for accessibility and additional functionality.

Continuing on to the Magma Club – a community center that once hosted dinners, dancing, swimming and boxing matches for Magma Mine workers – visitors can enjoy a free antique show. The show will feature a selection of quality antiques for sale, as well as live music on the Club's spacious veranda.

In addition to these intriguing buildings, the Tour will feature captivating stories about Superior's past told by professional historians. For instance, Wyatt Earp, an acclaimed performer and relative of the legendary Wyatt Earp, will present a short play called "Life on the Frontier." Stories of Mattie Earp, the common law wife of the elder Wyatt, will be shared; Mattie is buried in Superior. A lifelong

Superior resident will also share folklore and interesting information about various aspects of the town's history. For those who would like an even more up-close view of Superior and its past, there will be guided hikes to the old tunnel.

Another popular feature of the Tour is the selection of exquisite, handcrafted pottery from the village of Mata Ortiz in Mexico. The artists themselves will be displaying their wares – and weather permitting, they will fire pieces in an open flame to demonstrate how the pottery is made!

Each year, attendees of the Home and Building Tour enjoy learning about Superior's fascinating history while observing how the town has been forging a unique new identity. Pre-sale tickets for the Tour are \$15 at <https://bit.ly/3tn5E4z>. Sales at the door are \$18. All ticket holders receive 2 for 1 tickets to the Renaissance Festival and the Boyce Thompson Arboretum! Please bring a mask as some property owners may require them for entry. Recently, State and National media have reported an increase in positive COVID-19 Cases and the new Omicron variant is spreading across the globe and has been reported in Arizona. The CDC has now reported that quarantine period for those infected can be reduced to five days, versus the 10-day period. Copper Area News collects this data from the Arizona Department of Health website, these case numbers do not necessarily reflect tests that are taken with at home tests.

The communities of the Copper Corridor continue to see an elevated increase in new cases. The CDC and other health officials warn that those who are not vaccinated should continue to practice physical distancing, wear masks in public and avoid crowded places and is also strongly recommending everyone wear a mask indoors and in group settings. There are also incidences of break through cases where people who have been vaccinated do become ill, however those breakthrough cases generally have been mild cases and the chance of death is not as high as those for unvaccinated. The Omicron variant is showing additional symptoms such a sore throat and runny nose, which is similar to the common cold. It is recommended if you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19 or cold/flu symptoms to get tested.

COVID Vaccines are readily available at local clinics in the region including Cobre Valley Clinics in Superior and Kearny, Pinal County Public Health and Sun Life Clinics. Other chain pharmacies such as Walgreens, grocery store pharmacies and CVS also have vaccines available.

Above is a chart showing the number of total cases for each of the Copper Corridor communities Jan. 11, 2021, and Jan. 24. Keep in mind that zip code data also includes unincorporated areas around a community. For instance, Riverside/Kelvin area is included in the Kearny zip code. Aravaipa and Dudleyville are included in the Winkelman zip codes, etc.

Those experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should seek testing and quarantine until they can confirm a negative test.

BLM seeks seasonal call-when-needed firefighters

SAFFORD, Ariz. – The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Gila District is currently recruiting applicants for seasonal call-when-needed wildland firefighters for the 2022 fire season. Wildland firefighters provide a valuable service, protecting American communities and public lands.

To serve on a wildland fire crew, persons must be at least 18 years of age, have a strong work ethic, be able to pass a fitness test and medical exam, maintain good physical fitness, travel out of state for extended periods, and contribute to a team-structured environment. If selected, the selectee must comply with Executive Order 14043 - Federal employees are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Applications will be accepted through March 18. Applicants will be notified in April regarding their selection for one of the 20 firefighter positions. and can apply the following ways:

- Request, and send forms back, by email, to the email address provided below.
- Pick up and drop off forms at the Safford Field Office located at 711 S. 14th Ave. The front desk is open to in-person walk-in service — applicants who wish to pick-up or drop-off forms may do so and must comply with posted COVID-19 safety protocols.

While most fire duties will be in southeastern Arizona, some assignments may be out of state and last 14 consecutive days, plus travel time. Recruits will be classified as Administratively Determined (AD) Emergency Firefighters, hired on a call-when-needed basis, and are only paid during fire and/or work assignments; pay is \$19.72 per hour.

Recruits will receive classroom and field training, and all essential equipment assigned that will enable them to perform wildfire suppression safely and effectively.

Time trial bike race rolls through San Manuel

That's where the riders would use whatever they had left to cross that finish line, in their race against time.
