Melvin Joseph Ellsworth

Melvin was born in Pioche, Nevada on July 9, 1935. He was an avid outdoorsman, hunter and fisherman all his life and loved to work with rocks and lapidary equipment. Melvin was a heavy weight boxer in high school. He started out at 16 working in a foundry in Wallace, ID. He moved to Arizona and started working at Magma Copper in the mines. He married his high school sweetheart Anita Louise Culp in San Manuel, AZ on July 16, 1954. He worked as a Train Engineer for Magma Copper for quite a

Life and legacy of Lavinia Steward at Oracle Historical Society presentation

Lavinia Steward was a prominent Oracle resident and philanthropist. Her home still stands behind the old Circle K, now Way of the Bean coffee shop, in Oracle. Her contributions to the area include building the first library/reading room in Oracle, willing her home as a Masonic tuberculosis sanitarium and donating the money for the telescope and observatory at the University of Arizona known as the Steward Observatory.

Around 40 people enjoyed Alan Biel's presentation at

the Acadia Ranch Museum on Jan. 22. The presentation, "Lavinia Steward, the James Webb Telescope and Time Travel," was interesting and entertaining.

Biel is an amateur astronomer and astrophotographer. He shared some of his amazing astrophotography pictures with the audience.

Mrs. Steward's gift to the U of A helped make Arizona a world-renowned locale for astronomy research and education. Her legacy lives on at the Steward Observatory and at Kitt Peak where the telescope she made possible now stands.

The presentation was sponsored by the Oracle Historical Society.


