

OBITUARY

Donald Heitz Shelton



Don Heitz Shelton passed away in the evening of Feb. 9, 2022. He was born in St. Louis, MO, on Aug. 31, 1940, to parents, Walter H. Shelton and Margaretha Heitz Shelton. He moved to Tucson at age 8, where he grew up and raised a family.

After graduating from Amphitheater High School in 1958, he served in USAF from 1959-1963. His rank was A/1C E4 Crew Chief

and aircraft mechanic on T-33 aircraft. Once leaving the Air Force, he joined Magma Copper Company Jan. 15, 1965, where he worked 33 years, 3 months. Don was

immediately active in union representation and later leadership, which led to being involved in important US historical events in the labor/management movement.

During his employment at Magma (later BHP), he was active in labor bargaining, beginning with the Mine, Mill Steelworkers-USWA. Don was the last surviving member of the historical merger meeting held at the Pioneer Hotel in Tucson, Feb. 1966. He was President of the Local #937 Steelworkers from 1982-1991 and he served as President of the AZ AFLCIO from 1987-88.

Don helped lead the transformation of the BHP acquisition of Magma and extended the life of this operation, which affected so many working families and the local community. After the mine closed, he was a Labor Management Consultant, which took him to Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa, bringing his expertise to multiple types of labor industries.

His hobby was woodworking and he loved spending time

with his family on camping trips and vacations. He was an avid Raiders fan that even involved going to live games.

He married Rosalie Redding, in 1962, in VA, where they met on a blind date on Halloween!

He is survived by children, David Shelton (Teri) and Diane Shelton (Paul Brown); grandchildren, Arianna Vander-Heyden (Josh), Austin Shelton and Aaron Shelton; and great-grand-daughters, Adalynn and Josie Rose Vander-Heyden. He is also survived by a sister, Margaret Lee, and brothers, Roger Shelton and Larry Dawson.

A service is being held at Casas Adobes United Church of Christ, 6801 N. Oracle Road, Tucson, AZ on June 2, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. Interment will be at AZ Veteran's Memorial Cemetery, 15950 N. Lockett Road, Marana, AZ, following the service. In lieu of flowers, donations can be made to a favorite charity, preferably those who support veterans in need.

Pinal County hosts meeting in San Manuel to discuss redistricting

After the new census comes out every ten years, updated population data is provided. To make sure that all five of the districts remain substantially equal, Pinal County requires a revision to Supervisor districts. Part of the redistricting process also sees Voter and Justice Precincts being updated.

On Thursday, Feb. 17, a community meeting was held at the San Manuel Community Center to discuss the Pinal County Redistricting that will be happening in March. There to discuss it and answer questions were District 1 Supervisor Kevin Cavanaugh, Deputy County Manager Himanshu Patel, Deputy County Attorney Allen Quist, and Director of communications James Daniels.

At the front of the community center were maps of the proposed redistricting, which are available to view on the Pinal County website.

“Are these all the proposals on the table?” Cavanaugh asked Patel, referring to the two maps at the front.

“For the time being yes,” Patel told the audience, “Based on the comments we get

from the public, we’ll be coming to the board with different ideas.”

Pinal County staff has presented two options for the Board of Supervisors to vote on. Prior to the Board of Supervisors voting on final maps, there are a series of community input listening sessions. Both proposals will chop up the eastern portion of the County.

Plan A proposes that Superior join a district with Apache Junction, Gold Canyon, Queen Valley, Top of the World and a small portion of unincorporated population north of the San Tan Valley Area. This district would be known as District 5. Kearny, Mammoth, Aravaipa, San Manuel, Mammoth and Oracle would remain in District 1 with this district also including Florence and Coolidge, along with all the unincorporated areas in between. The communities south of Oracle including SaddleBrooke, Marana and Red Rock will remain in District 4.

Plan B proposes that Superior and Kearny join District 5, which would also include a small portion of prison population in Florence, Apache Junction, Queen Valley, Gold Canyon, Top of the World and a small area north of San Tan Valley.

Two Miner wrestlers place at state championships

The San Manuel wrestling team had four wrestlers compete in the Division IV State Wrestling Tournament over the weekend. On Friday, Feb. 18, Raymond Garcia, Jakob Tafoya, Aiden Lozoya and Aedon Hawkins geared up to wrestle at the Arizona Veterans Memorial Colosseum.

The first round saw Garcia win in 7-1 match against Tuba City. Tafoya was able to defeat Fountain Hills with a pin in the second period. Lozoya faced off against Mogollon, and found the pin for a first period win. Hawkins wrestled against Miami, but lost by fall.

The second round of wrestling started off with Garcia versus Parker's 113-lb wrestler. His match started off with intensity. He was able to gain control of the match from the beginning, working for points. Garcia won in the second period by a technical fall, with a score of 16-0. Tafoya faced off against Yuma Catholic for round two, but was sent to the consolation round after losing by

fall. Lozoya also wrestled against Parker. It was a tough match that started with a battle for control. Lozoya lost the match by a 3-5 point decision, sending him to the consolation round as well.

In the first round of consolations, Hawkins found himself passing to the next round because of a forfeit. In the second round of consolations, Tafoya wrestled against Wickenburg. Tafoya took control of the match once he got the first takedown, and kept it. He started to tire out in the third period, but held strong for a 6-2 point decision win. Lozoya pushed the intensity for his consolation round two match against Bagdad. Despite Lozoya only winning by two points in the 10-8 decision, he kept control during the whole match. Hawkins wrestled against Mica Mountain during the consolation's second round. The match was quick but tough, Hawkins fought for control, but both wrestlers struggled to find it, until Mica Mountain found control in the form of a headlock. Hawkins lost by fall in the second period, putting him out of the tournament.

The third round of consolations started off with Tafoya against St. Johns. Tafoya wrestled with toughness, keeping control of the match until the third period. The last period found Tafoya struggling to keep down St. Johns. The match ended with St. Johns pinning Tafoya, ending his quest for a state medal. Lozoya wrestled against Joseph City for his third round consolation match. Lozoya found control of the match in the second period, keeping it for the remainder, winning in a 6-2 decision.


The first day of wrestling ended with Garcia's semi-final match against Morenci. The match started off with intensity, while Garcia fought for control, but Morenci secured it. Throughout the match they would trade off control, but Morenci walked away with the pin in the third period.

The second day started with Garcia and Lozoya being the remaining Miner Wrestlers in the tournament. Garcia received a forfeit for his first match of the day, advancing him to the final round for third place. Lozoya faced off against Camp Verde for his first match of the day, but lost

by fall in the second period. Lozoya was set to wrestle for fifth place.

For his final match Garcia wrestled against Miami, but lost by fall, ending the tournament in fourth place. Lozoya faced Yuma Catholic for his final match, winning by a 3-1 decision, securing the fifth place medal. The Miners finished in 18th place for Division IV.

"I knew going into the season, we had the potential to compete at a high level. We have a motivated group who truly didn't know what they were capable of achieving. This season was full of distractions and speed-bumps, but we stayed on course and kept moving forward. Our wrestlers stayed focused and that's why we were able to persevere," commented head coach Daniel Najera. "Our team is returning two state placers, four state qualifiers, and 11 varsity wrestlers. I'm looking forward to this off-season so we can continue to build our foundation and keep moving in the right direction. Our staff is very appreciative of everyone that supported our program. Thank you."

School Board seats open throughout the Copper Corridor

Are you concerned with our local schools having effective leadership and quality educational programs? If so, it is a great time to consider stepping up and running for election for the available positions on local school boards.

All governing board positions listed below have a term expiration of Dec. 31, 2022. The seats will be on the November 2022 ballots. Open seats include:

- Oracle – two seats with a four-year term each, which are currently held by Gary Terrell and Jeri Taylor; 73 signatures are required.

- Ray – three seats, two of which are currently held by Jason Wernett and Jonathan Ramirez and have a two-year term, and one of which has a four-year term and is held by Tino Flores; 11 signatures are required.

- Mammoth-San Manuel – three seats, two with four-year terms, currently held by Terry Newman and Louie Madrid, and one with a two-year term, currently held by Michael Carnes; 15 signatures are required.

- Superior – four seats, one with a two-year term and is currently held by Henry Guterrez; two with four-year terms that are currently held by Ricardo Provencio and Ignacio Magallanes; and one with a four-year term that is currently vacant; 11 signatures are required.

- CVIT – one seat (Superior School District) with a four-year term currently filled by Louie Rabago; 11 signatures are required.

ly/3JKLK8K. This one does not need to be notarized and can be submitted in person, by mail or email to the Pinal County School Office (mkrumrey@pinalco.org).

Two locals have filed their intents to run already: Jeri Taylor for Oracle and Louie Madrid for Mammoth-San Manuel.

Once the Candidate Statement of Interest form has been received by the County School Office and date stamped, the candidate can begin gathering signatures on the Candidate Nomination Form-Nonpartisan and Petitions. Any gathered prior to the date stamp will be nullified. Submit to Pinal County School Office, 75 North Bailey St., Florence, 85132. The filing period for submission of this form and petitions is from 8 a.m. Monday June 10, 2022, until 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 11, 2022. Candidates may not circulate petitions before submitting a Candidate Statement of Interest form first.

The majority of questions from those in attendance in San Manuel were concerns of gerrymandering, which is manipulation of boundaries as to favor one political party or class.

“When we looked at the primary aspect here in creating these [maps] was strictly population. We never evaluate voter roles, in terms of what political party, or how many voters are in which party whether Republican or Democrat,” Himanshu Patel reassured the audience, “We strictly focused on population.”

The redistricting will not take effect until the next election in 2024. This will allow for voters to either vote

for incumbent or another candidate.
