AZ Air National Guard, World View staff utilizing San Manuel Airport

Things are really hopping at the San Manuel Airport. Earlier this month, two groups found space at the local airport for training and exploration.

Arizona Air National Guard members conducted training at and near the San Manuel Ray Blair Airport. Guard Members utilized the UH-72A Lakota light utility helicopter while training.

The same day, World View staff launched a high-altitude balloon flight. The flight departed from the San Manuel Ray Blair Airport at approximately 10 a.m. The payload consisted of photography and videography equipment used to document and evaluate the curvature of the earth. The flight was scheduled to fly up to 75,000 feet with the payload being recovered near Duncan, Arizona later the same day. Additional launches from San Manuel are planned in the future. These flights help train staff.

San Manuel Airport, also known as San Manuel Ray Blair Airport, is a public-use airport that is publicly owned and operated by Pinal County.

World View Enterprises, Inc., doing business as World View, is a private American near-space exploration and technology company headquartered in Tucson, Arizona, founded with the goal of increasing access to and the utilization of the stratosphere for scientific, commercial, and economic purposes. They hope to offer human spaceflight experience beginning as soon as 2023 or 2024.
