
The economy over the past several years has also changed. We've made the business decision to consolidate our offices into one location. The San Manuel office is the smallest of our three locations. It is also our oldest location.







- Non-healing wounds, such as a diabetic foot ulcer
- Radiation injury
- Vascular wounds
- Skin graft or skin flap at risk of tissue death
- Wounds that won't heal

During Hyperbaric Therapy

Hyperbaric oxygen therapy typically is performed as an outpatient procedure and doesn't require hospitalization. If you're already hospitalized and require hyperbaric oxygen therapy, you'll remain in the hospital for therapy. During hyperbaric oxygen therapy, the air pressure in the room is about two to three times normal air pressure. The increased air pressure will create a temporary feeling of fullness in your ears — similar to what you might feel in an airplane or at a high elevation. You can relieve

that feeling by yawning or swallowing. For most conditions, therapy lasts approximately two hours. Members of our health care team will monitor you and the therapy unit throughout your treatment.


