She graduated from Mingus Union High School in Jerome in 1965 and started attending Arizona State College – Flagstaff, which was renamed Northern Arizona

University at the end of her freshman year. She graduated in 1969 as an educator and moved to Kearny after being offered a contract to work as a business teacher at Ray High School. After 32 years of teaching full time, she retired in 2001, although she substituted for several years thereafter.

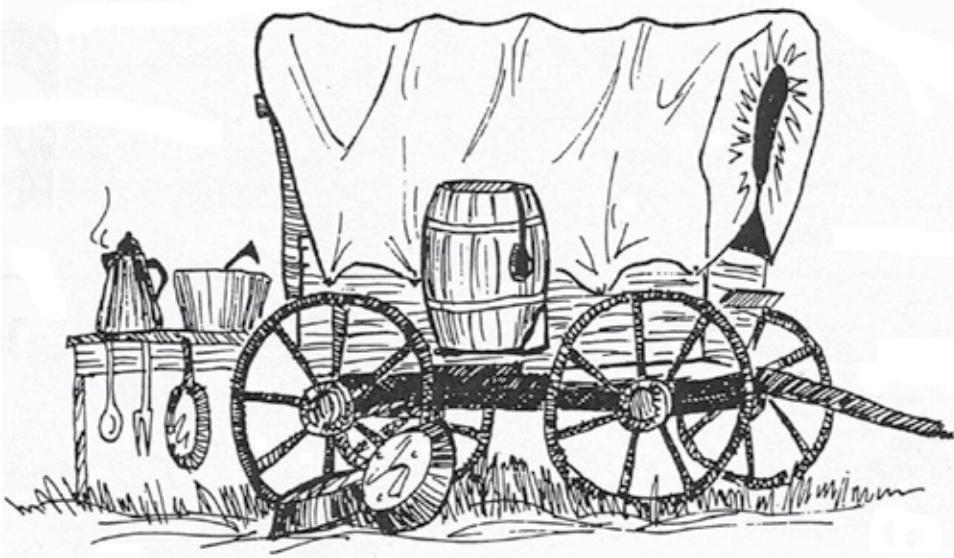

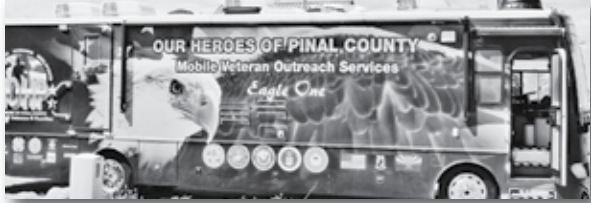
