CAHRA to help with rent during COVID-19 emergency

There may be some relief in sight for people who rent in Pinal County. For those affected by the COVID-19 emergency, especially those who have been furloughed or have seen a reduction in salary, funds will soon be available to help out with rent.

The Community Action Human Resources Agency (CAHRA), the designated Community Action Agency for Pinal County, was recently notified that it will be receiving \$150,000 through a contract with Arizona Department of Housing. These funds will be able to help so many affected by furloughs or reduction in hours due to COVID-19, according to Jon Thompson, CAHRA Board President.

right away to let them know if you may need rental assistance or a payment plan for your next monthly rental payment. Early communication with residents and managers allows for more time to respond and explore all options."

The participant is asked to respond to a pre-application found at https://www.saveourhomeaz.gov/RA/. They initially go on the site and answer the questions. If they meet the initial requirements they are told to call their specific community action agency and the contact information in their area. If a participant has trouble with the website, they can call CAHRA for help signing up. Arizona renter households who have suffered a substantial loss of income resulting from COVID-19, including job loss, reduction in compensated hours of work, or other loss of income related to COVID-19, and do not have financial resources to cover their rent may be eligible to receive assistance with rent due on a primary residence in Arizona. income adjusted for household size and varies by county. Applicants will be responsible for paying 30% of the total current gross monthly income of the household for rent; households with rent payments that are at or below 30% of their total gross monthly income will not be eligible for assistance.

Documents that must be provided are identification (driver's license or state issued identification card), copy of lease, proof of income, documentation of financial impact related to COVID-19 (letter from employer regarding layoff or cut in hours, or documentation from doctor to quarantine resulting in loss of income).

Complete applications are reviewed on a first come, first served basis. Only fully completed applications that provide all required documentation will be reviewed for eligibility. Applicants who receive a notice of incomplete application with instructions on missing information must successfully provide all necessary information to move their application forward. Incomplete applications shall be on hold until all information is received. Applicants who fail to provide all required information or are found ineligible based on the program's requirements will not receive assistance. Applications that could be considered eligible may not receive assistance if funding is no longer available based on demand.

If eligible the agency will notify the applicant and the landlord and will pay the landlord/property owner directly.

CAHRA has received 94 calls to the office and many through the ADOH portal. The portal has some glitches and many from Pinal are being directed to other Community Action Agencies. ADOH is repairing the issue.

"If those that have registered through the portal and have not received a call from CAHRA within a week, please call the office at 520-466-1112," Thompson said.

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

How Important Are Thyroid Tests?

The thyroid is the regulator of your metabolic rate, akin to the idle in your car. It adjusts its influence on your "peppiness" on a millisecond to millisecond basis. To properly test its functionality there are common tests available from a standard lab, Most frequently, if the thyroid is to be evaluated at all, it is done with only one lab test and that is the TSH. This Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH) emanates from the brain (pituitary gland) and signals the thyroid to speed up or slow down.

Let us look at symptoms and tests to help evaluate the thyroid. Symptoms of note include sluggishness, easy weight gain, brittle nails, hair loss, dry skin and, at times, constipation, increased cholesterol readings and lower basal body temperatures all reflecting a slower metabolism.

The thyroid's primary function in regulating the metabolism is to assemble two raw materials to make its hormone, thyroxine (T4). These two materials are the amino acid tyrosine and the mineral iodine...as in one Tyrosine matched with 4 iodine. This hormone then needs to drop one if its iodines to form the hormone of greatest function, T3. This occurs in the liver and kidneys with the help of the mineral selenium. On occasion this process can get shunted and form more of what's called "reverse" T3 that undermines the production of the regular T3 that is essential for metabolic efficiency, or optimal "idle" position.


The body is extremely complex with all of its inner workings. There are two major systems in the body that highly influence the efficiency of the thyroid. One is the immune system. It can be misguided to produce anti-bodies to protect you against thyroid elements that it perceives as threatening to your well being. The two anti-bodies that have been recognized and had tests developed for are the Thyro-PerOxidase Antibody (TPO Ab) and the Thyrogobulin Antibody (Tg Ab). These antibodies can interfere with the functioning of the thyroid and actually injure the gland permanently. This attack on the thyroid is sometimes labelled with a person's name, Hashimoto's Disease. It is what's known as an auto-immune condition, or attack on one's self.

Another system that interferes with the thyroid is the adrenal system. Stress can produce an overabundance of cortisol (an adrenal hormone like adrenalin). Cortisol can block the conversion of the thyroid hormone (T4) to its more functional form (T3).

Considerations that lead one to suspect thyroid dysfunction include symptomatology, family history and exposure to toxins, in particular radioactive toxins.

Tests that help identify the mechanisms of dysfunction include: TSH, fT4 ("free" T4), fT3, rT3 ("reverse" T3), TPO Ab, Tg Ab, and Cortisol. Of these, the one test that will most likely identify a dysfunction is the fT3. That is the messenger (hormone) that triggers metabolic activity throughout the body, like the idle in your car.

Latest Governor Executive Orders: beauty, barber shops closed; playgrounds open; rental eviction prevention







Per the Governor's orders, Oracle State Park is open. Practice social distancing while enjoying a hike or bike ride at the park. John Hernandez | Miner

Mayors across the state called on Governor Doug Ducey to refine the essential services list. In the original listing, barber shops, beauty salons, massage clinics and nail salons were allowed to stay open. Parks and golf courses were also allowed to remain open. On Friday, the Governor issued an executive order to close the beauty services listed above and allowed for playgrounds, basketball courts and other park amenities to remain open as long as they allowed for proper social distancing. Golf courses are still allowed to remain open.

Amenities such as playgrounds, basketball courts, picnic areas and restrooms at parks throughout the Copper Area readership will be closed. Swimming pools may also be closed. The Town of Hayden announced that the park will be fully closed on Easter Weekend to ensure that groups do not congregate in those places. The Town of Winkelman has also closed the Winkelman Flats Park for the Easter Weekend. The Town of Kearny has closed their parks and the Town of Superior has closed all playground structures and basketball courts. The open spaces of the parks will remain open and all trails remain open in Superior.

The Boyce Thompson Arboretum remains open but those planning to visit the park should make a reservation to attend. Park administration is limiting the attendance into the park to help maintain physical distancing. Arizona State Parks and Trails are open, but all events, group gatherings, and Cave Tours have been cancelled. Park officials are taking the necessary precautions for our visitors and staff as recommended by the CDC and Arizona Department of Health Services.

Oracle State Park remains committed to providing open spaces, hiking trails, and outdoor destinations for people to safely enjoy in small groups.

Likewise, the Kearny Lake is open for those who would like to get out and enjoy the beautiful spring weather.

On Monday, Governor Ducey also issued another Executive Order which prevented commercial property evictions for 60 days. Congress passed a COVID-19 stimulus bill that will allow small business owners to apply for funding for payrolls and other business costs such as rent and utilities.
