

Multi-alarm fire destroys residence south of Mammoth

Firefighters from Pinal Rural, Mammoth, San Manuel, Oracle, Golder

Ranch and Winkelman Fire Agencies battled a residential structure with

strong winds blowing on May 8. According to Pinal

Rural Fire and Medical District Fire Chief Bobby Apodaca, the fire district was dispatched to a residential fire in the 86000 block of E. Barrows Place, Mammoth, at approximately 3 p.m.

When firefighters arrived, they found a well involved residential fire. The firefighters took quick action to keep the fire from spreading to any other structures. With the red flag warning and strong winds blowing, two small vegetation fires started, but were held to less than one acre. One person was transported to a local burn center with unknown injuries. There were no firefighters injured. The fire was controlled at 7:02 p.m. The fire caused extensive damage to the residence and garage.

"I would like to thank the firefighters from Mammoth, San Manuel, Oracle, Golder Ranch and Winkelman for their assistance battling this fire. Without their help, there would have been much more damage and structures threatened," Apodaca said.

Investigators are determining the cause of the Sunday afternoon

blaze. They do not believe foul play was involved in this incident. Damage

estimates are expected to exceed \$100,000 for this incident.

Stage 1 fire restrictions in effect for Pinal Rural Fire and Medical District

Exceptional drought status, dry fuels, coupled with upcoming continued dry weather, prompts the Pinal Rural Fire and Medical District (PRFMD) to implement fire restrictions.

Beginning May 6, 2022, at 8 a.m., PRFMD will implement Stage I Fire Restrictions in our Fire District including state-owned and managed lands.

"The goal of the fire restrictions is to protect public health by reducing the number of preventable human-caused wildfires. Restrictions will remain in effect until fire officials determine that conditions have changed sufficiently to reduce the risk of human-caused wildfire," said Bobby Apodaca, PRFMD Fire Chief.

Stage I fire restrictions prohibit the following:

- Igniting, building, maintaining or using a fire, including charcoal and briquettes, outside a fire structure. Using charcoal or briquettes in a residence is never recommended.
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three (3) feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of any flammable material.
- Discharging a firearm, except while engaged in a lawful hunt pursuant to state, federal, or tribal laws and regulations.

Board of Supervisors looking at long-term debt proposal in Pinal County

The Board of Supervisors will be looking at a long-term debt proposal in Pinal County.

The long-term debt will be used to acquire land (or interests in land) for economic development purposes which would be utilized for future industrial, manufacturing, distribution, or similar activities and projects so that, in accordance with Section 11-254.04, Arizona Revised Statutes, the County can provide assistance or undertakings, improvements, leasing or future conveyance of the same to spur industrial growth by

attracting business and corporate development, expansion or relocation to enhance the economic welfare and job growth for the County's inhabitants.

The total estimated financing cost will be \$266,344,787, consisting of an estimated principal amount of \$126,595,000 and total estimated interest of \$139,749,787.

The public hearing is scheduled to take place during the Board of Supervisors' meeting on Wednesday, May 18, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. The Supervisors will hear this item as part of a public hearing during the regularly scheduled

meeting. The public is invited to comment on this issue at the public hearing or by emailing: ClerkoftheBoard@pinal.gov.

Earlier this year, the United States Air Force conducted a series of public hearings and conducted a public scoping comment period for proposed changes to air space use in Arizona including much of the Copper Corridor.

In the scoping document for the EIS, the Air Force

explained that in order to continue to train properly they need to utilize existing military air space more aggressively, as other air spaces are more congested. This will also allow airmen to train and practice closer to their home bases. The air spaces are used primarily

by Davis Monthan Air Force Base, Luke Air Force Base and Morris ANGB.

The majority of the Copper Corridor is affected by these plans as the communities of Superior, Miami, Globe, Kearny and Mammoth are

located within the Outlaw MOA, with San Manuel and Oracle just outside of the Outlaw district. The Jackal MOA also covers the mountains and canyons such as the Aravaipa Canyon all the way to Safford.

Specifically for the Outlaw and Jackal MOAs, their requested changes would include: flights being operated from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday. Currently they are allowed to fly until 6 p.m. and from 6 to 10 p.m. but only with certain permissions via NOTEM. They are also requesting to drop flares at 500 feet in elevation. They are also requesting permission to lower the elevation where flares can be released and also lower the elevation of supersonic flying.

The original scoping period closed out on March 4, 2022. Several local municipalities, including the Town of Superior, City of Globe, Town of Miami, Capstone Copper Mining and Resolution Copper submitted comments in the original scoping period. This past week, the United States Air Force announced that they have extended the comment period and members of the public can provide input and comments through June 3, 2022. Those who have already submitted comments, do not have to resubmit, those comments are currently under review. It is not uncommon

for the comment periods for these federal processes to be extended. Usually the extensions are requested to ensure everyone who needs to make comment has ample time to submit their comments.

As the EIS process continues, those entities and individuals who have submitted comments will have what is called "standing" in the process. This ensures those with standing will also be allowed to provide comments and input throughout the entire process.

At this time no specific changes to the use of the military air space have occurred, this Environmental Impact Statement is a required process to assess potential risks and benefits to the environment and residents of the region, should their request be granted. It is believed by some authorities that the Telegraph and Mescal fires last year were started by military flares during practice maneuvers.

Motorcycle museum breathes new life into once-abandoned building

New life has been brought to the old Fast Stop building that used to sit vacant on San Manuel's Main Street.

Two years ago, longtime resident, Parrish Traweek purchased a building that had been weathered on the outside, and abused by trespassers on the inside.

"I was raised in San Manuel, then I was gone 22 years in the military, and when I came back it was terrible. I'd drive by this place everyday and it would make me sick [to see it that way]," said Parrish. He purchased it before whispers of the building's demolition could become true.

Today, the building now houses the JWJ Cycles Motorcycle Museum. JWJ is named in memory of Parrish's father Jack, his uncle Warren, and his wife Jill. Inside the building is a wide collection of bikes that Parrish has collected over the years, including bikes that he and his family used in competitions. Various awards and trophies rest on shelves, books on motorcycles rest atop the tables, and memorabilia covers the walls.

"Our family moved to Arizona to ride motorcycles, and I collected these bikes through the years, and they were in an airplane hangar, because I had no place to put them," Parrish commented, "So we needed somewhere to put the motorcycles, and I didn't originally buy this as a business, I just bought it as a 'man-cave.'" The museum now offers private tours, events, and group staging. They are planning to open a small coffee and pastry shop inside the museum by the fall of 2023, with hopes of making it a popular travel stop for riders passing

through. They will also have the famous Vern's Nachos from back in the day, with the original recipe from Vern Stover.
