


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

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School Board seats open throughout the Copper Corridor

Are you concerned with our local schools having effective leadership and quality educational programs? If so, it is a great time to consider stepping up and running for election for the available positions on local school boards.

All governing board positions listed below have a term expiration of Dec. 31, 2022. The seats will be on the November 2022 ballots. Open seats include:

- Oracle – two seats with a four-year team each, which are currently held by Gary Terrell and Jeri Taylor; 73 signatures are required.
- Ray – three seats, which are currently held by Jason Wernett (two-year term), Jonathan Ramirez (four-year term) and Tino Flores (four-year term); 11 signatures are required.
- Mammoth-San Manuel – three seats, two with four-year terms, currently held by Terry Newman and Louis Madrid, and one with a two-year term, currently held by Michael Carnes; 15 signatures are required.
- Superior – four seats, one with a two-year term and is currently held by Henry Gutierrez; two with four-year terms that are currently held by Ricardo Provencio and Ignacio Magallanes; and one with a four-year term that is currently vacant; 11 signatures are required.
- CVIT – one seat (Superior School District) with a four-year term currently filled by Louie Rabago; 11 signatures are required.


This one does not need to be notarized and can be submitted in person, by mail or email to the Pinal County School Office (mkrumrey@pinalco.org).

Several locals have filed their intents to run already: Jeri Taylor for Oracle and Louis Madrid for Mammoth-San Manuel were the first to file. Also intending to run are: Donna Pedota (Oracle), Wendy Biallas-Odell (Oracle), Gary Terrell (Oracle), Augustine-Lou Hing (Superior), Ericka Vasquez (Superior), Hector Aparacio (Superior), Henry Gutierrez (Superior)

Once the Candidate Statement of Interest form has been received by the County School Office and date stamped, the candidate can begin gathering signatures on the Candidate Nomination Form-Nonpartisan and Petitions. Any gathered prior to the date stamp will be nullified. Submit to Pinal County School Office, 75 North Bailey St., Florence, 85132. The filing period for submission of this form and petitions is from 8 a.m. Monday June 10, 2022, until 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 11, 2022. Candidates may not circulate petitions before submitting a Candidate Statement of Interest form first.

Supervisor Cavanaugh to offer Copper Corridor farewell town hall; redistricting has resulted in change of Supervisors



On May 7, 2022, join Supervisor Kevin Cavanaugh for a farewell Town Hall in the San Manuel Community Center at 4:30 p.m.; 111 W. Fifth Ave., San Manuel, AZ 85631.



Redistricting requires that populations of Supervisor Districts be within 10% of each other, and District 1, formerly comprising the Copper Corridor, Coolidge and parts of Florence, was less than half the population of the largest district – San Tan. Redistricting also requires that districts be as compact as possible, so the County Management Team devised a map splitting eastern Pinal County into north and south sections. Supervisor Cavanaugh will now be responsible for portions of Coolidge, Queen Creek, the Ak-Chin, Gila River Indian Community, local members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe, and the City of Maricopa.

Initially recognizing a need for broadband in the Copper Corridor to drive economic growth, Cavanaugh worked with County Managers to develop a plan utilizing existing fiber cable to bring new infrastructure to the Corridor. The project had been stalled when Supervisor Cavanaugh took office, and he pressed in and helped to allocate funding for the project. He has assisted District 1 businesses in navigating difficult planning and zoning situations (keeping several businesses from giving up on Pinal County entirely), supported economic and community development projects, and aided municipal departments in securing necessary resources.

The Town Hall on May 7 in San Manuel will be an opportunity for Supervisor Cavanaugh to thank residents for the privilege to be their voice in County government. Updates will be provided on projects which will be transferred to the new District Supervisor. The entire Copper Corridor, from SaddleBrooke Ranch to Superior, is invited and encouraged to attend.

Earlier this month, rumors of the San Manuel Historic Museum shutting down began to circulate throughout the town.

The San Manuel Historic Society wants to let the community know that they will not be shutting down, but instead they will be reorganizing. Hazel Cooper will be taking over as president, Dorothy Van Dielen will be taking over as treasurer, and David Prough will be the new director. It is only \$15 a year to become a member of the San Manuel Historic Society. Additionally, those who donate \$50 will be part of the Silver Club, while those who \$100 or more will be part of the Gold Club, and donors name will be displayed on a plaque. "We have no source of income, so we need

community support," said Hazel Cooper. "We would really appreciate if a business could donate to us."

Aside from cash donations, the San Manuel Historic Society is also looking for donations of photos and memorabilia that can help tell the story of San Manuel's history, outside of its mining legacy.

"The reason why I took over? I'm going to be 90 in November, and I did not want to lose all of those artifacts that are in that museum," Hazel Cooper added. "I have lived here for 67 years, I have seen the beginning, and I'm hoping that we are going to begin again."

San Manuel Lady Miners head into the 1A State Tourney seeded #1

The Lady Miners head into the first round of the 1A State Playoffs today, seeded as #1 in the state. They host Fort Thomas at 4 p.m.

The Lady Miners took to the field last week to keep their hot-streak alive, and secured two wins. On April 26, the girls traveled to Miami to take on the Vandals. The Lady Miners kicked off the game with three runs in the first inning, and kept the runs coming throughout the game. The game ended after the fifth inning, with a final score of 19-2.

Aubrey Encinas lead the team at the plate, with 5 hits, followed by Celeste Flores with 4 hits, and Jazmyne Waddell with 3 hits. Encinas also had 5 RBIs, Waddell had 4 RBIs, and Laila Ruiz had 3 RBIs. Pitching all five innings was Jazmyne Waddell, collecting 7 strikeouts, and 20 first pitch strikes.

The following day, the Lady Miners traveled to Tucson

to play against St. Augustine Catholic. The girls once again showed up with a strong first inning, scoring 8 runs. St. Augustine was only able to post 1 run to the board in the fourth inning. The game ended after that inning with a final score of 16-1, giving the Lady Miners their second win of the week.

Leading at the plate for this game was Jazmyne Waddell with 4 hits and 6 RBIs, followed by Laila Ruiz with 3 hits and 4 RBIs, then Jazlynn Clark with 2 hits and 2 RBIs. Waddell once again took the mound for this game, pitching 8 strikeouts.

The Lady Miners will begin their quest to the state finals on May 4, with the round one of the 1A state playoffs. It will be a home game against Fort Thomas. First pitch is at 4 p.m.

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
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
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Fire activity and very dry conditions trigger fire restrictions in

Phoenix, Ariz. (May 2, 2022) – Effective Thursday, May 5, the following agencies will implement campfire and smoking restrictions:


- Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Phoenix and Colorado River Districts;
- Coconino, Kaibab [Williams and Tusayan Ranger Districts], Prescott, Tonto, and Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests;
- Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management as it relates to state trust lands in Coconino County south of the Grand Canyon, Mohave, La Paz, Yavapai, Yuma, Maricopa, Gila, Graham, Greenlee, Apache, and Navajo counties.

Beginning May 5, 2022, and until rescinded, the following are prohibited:

- Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, charcoal, coal, or wood stove fire, except within a developed recreation site, or improved site.
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building. Smoking is prohibited in all federal buildings.

In addition, the BLM Phoenix and Colorado River Districts, Prescott and Tonto National Forests will

implement the following restriction, which temporarily prohibits recreational target shooting:

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• Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun, except while engaged in a lawful hunt pursuant to state, federal, or tribal law, and regulations.

Fireworks and exploding targets are never allowed on federal and state trust lands. Recreational target shooting is prohibited year-round on state trust lands.

Pressurized liquid or gas stoves, lanterns and heaters possessing shut-off devices are allowed. When using a portable stove, make sure the area is clear of grasses and other fine fuels. Prevent stoves from tipping and starting a fire.

Residents and visitors should check with respective county and municipal governments for information on fire restrictions in those jurisdictions.

National Park Service and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service units across Arizona maintain similar fire restrictions as those being implemented, year-round. Variations are possible, and visitors should check with the unit's visitor center for area-specific restrictions and regulations.

Violation of restrictions is punishable by fine, imprisonment or both. Violators may also be held personally responsible for reimbursement of fire suppression costs.

To prevent wildfires, never throw cigarettes out of a vehicle window. Use an ashtray instead. Never park a vehicle over dry grass as the catalytic converter can ignite the vegetation. Make sure your vehicle is in good operating condition, tires are well inflated, and check for any dragging metal or chains from towed trailers.

Fire conditions as well as localized closures and restrictions are subject to change. Tribal, federal, state, and local mandates are different, they may have some differences in their restriction notices. Support Local: Oracle Post Office

In April 2020, COVID-19 brought much of Arizona's economy to a screeching halt. All businesses not deemed "essential" were ordered closed by Arizona's governor Doug Ducey.

The lockdown continued for nearly two months. When Gov. Ducey finally gave the go ahead to reopen, businesses slowly began the road to recovery. Even those listed as "essential" had a challenge with this economic recovery.

Many small businesses and non-profits in Arizona didn't survive the lockdown. The businesses that did survive are hanging on as best they can. *Copper Area News* wanted to give something back to the local business community as a thank you for supporting us through these troubled times. Our newspapers (*Copper Basin News*, *Superior Sun* and *San Manuel Miner*) have been featuring local businesses and non-profits since the beginning of 2021, encouraging our readers to Shop at Home, stay local and support our local businesses. To date, *Copper Area News* has featured 142 businesses and groups in the Copper Corridor.

It's been said about the United States Postal Service: "Neither snow nor rain nor heat nor gloom of night stays these couriers from the swift completion of their appointed rounds." It's not their official motto – they actually have no motto at all (<https://facts.usps.com/no-official-motto/>).

Perhaps if we were to add a sentence about the COVID-19 Pandemic, it would be even more accurate.

The USPS, along with other delivery services, became a lifeline for many Americans locked down during the initial days of the pandemic. They didn't have the option to shut down. They were some of the unsung heroes – the frontline workers – tasked with keeping the economy going.

According to the United States Postal Service, "The Postal Service's mission is to provide the nation with reliable, affordable, universal mail service. The basic functions of the Postal Service were established in 39 U.S.C. § 101(a): ". . . to bind the Nation together through the personal, educational, literary, and business correspondence of the people. It [the Postal Service] shall provide prompt, reliable, and efficient services to patrons in all areas and shall render postal services to all communities." The Postal Service delivers to more than 150 million addresses six days a week and picks up pre-paid letters and packages at the time of delivery. It provides mailing and shipping services through more than 36,000 retail outlets and usps.com."

San Manuel's Post Office has been serving the residents of San Manuel for more than 67 years.

A little history ...

In the more than two centuries since Benjamin Franklin was appointed the country's first Postmaster General in 1775, the United States Post Office has grown and changed with America. Oracle's history with the institution doesn't go that far back in history, but is linked with the history of the state of Arizona.

Manlyville was located on what is the Willow Springs Ranch. Joseph Chamberlin established the ranch in 1880. The post office would be established on April 18, 1881. It was named Manlyville after Joseph Chamberlin's son Manly. Manly Chamberlin was the first Postmaster. Manlyville was also a stage stop between Tucson and

Riverside. The post office would be discontinued in 1888.

American Flag – Isaac Lorraine discovered and developed the American Flag Mine in the 1870s. Around 1877, he built a house which served as his residence and headquarters for his mining and ranching operations. The population around his mining camp and other nearby mines and ranches warranted a post office. On Dec. 28, 1880 the post office was established at American Flag and the house served as the first post office in the district. Peter H. Loss was the Postmaster. The post office was discontinued in 1890 and the mail service moved to Oracle. It is believed that the American Flag Ranch building is the oldest Arizona territorial post office still standing.

The Oracle post office was established on Dec. 28, 1880. James Branson was the Postmaster. It would be discontinued in 1883 and reestablished in January 1885 with Edwin Dodge as the Postmaster.

The Oracle Post Office has been in the current building at 905 E American Ave in Oracle for close to 40 years. They offer the standard post and mail courier services. The Postmaster is Tracy Alvarez.

The Oracle Post Office was the first post office to put in the COVID-19 preventative measures in the Tri-Community. The measures they started was putting up signage and plexiglass and shower curtain barricades at the counters. They also started wearing masks, enforcing the six-foot social distance rule and sanitizing everything.
