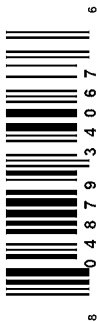

## LETTER TO THE EDITOR

# Pinal County Public School Districts - The Fabric of Our Community

For over a century, public school districts across Pinal County have been the fabric that holds our communities together. The excitement of game night, sounds of a band or choir performance, civic projects our students have participated in, fun of Homecoming, excitement of the Prom, joy of listening to the elementary Christmas concerts and the pride and excitement anytime one of our teams competes for a state championship are just a few of the many ways that our school districts help to bring our communities together. The pride shown by our alumni and strong positive bonds between our teachers and students allow our school districts to be the glue that binds our communities together and allows our children to have a positive childhood.

At the same time, as the largest employer in the community, our school districts are critical to the local economy. Eighty percent (80%) to eighty-five (85%) of our budgets go into salaries and benefits for our employees. Research shows that this money has a ripple effect on the local economy and is spent several times over in the community. Our employees, your friends and neighbors, buy homes, have spouses and children working in the community, and shop at our local restaurants, grocery stores and other retail stores. This investment and reinvestment of the school district budgets in our County is critical for the success of our communities and for the local economy.

This year the Arizona Legislature has an unprecedented budget surplus, and the state is experiencing historic gains in revenue. With over \$4.6 billion in ongoing and one-time revenue our Legislature is in the position to continue to support and build a stronger economy for our local communities and our state. As the Superintendents of the public schools in Pinal County, we believe that the time is right for a historic investment in K-12 education. By providing a substantial investment in public education our Legislature can ensure the continuation of a strong local economy.

Superintendents from around the state are asking for support from the business community, our local governments and our parents for the K-12 Education and Workforce Development priorities. These priorities will provide \$860 million in permanent funding for K-12 education and \$200 million of one-time funding for capital improvements. This \$1 billion investment in K-12 education provides for money to go to the base support level for school districts. What is important about this is that it means that our administrations and Governing

Boards can make the decisions on how to spend the increased funding. We believe that local control is critical in making decisions on how to spend additional funding. Local control is important because we know what is best for the students in our communities.

The educational priorities will also provide additional money for Career and Technical Education to support workforce development in Pinal County. Additional money will also be provided to help with the education of our most vulnerable students. This additional money will go to help students in special education or in areas of high poverty.

Finally, the priorities provide a process for which to address fundamental issues within the K-12 funding formula to ensure that school districts can spend these additional funds. Addressing the Aggregate Expenditure Limit (AEL), exempting Proposition 301 from the AEL and eliminating Proposition 123 spending limits, will ensure that this historic investment in K-12 public education has the maximum positive impact on our students across the County. Our children are our future. The role of our school districts in creating the fabric that holds our communities together requires a continued investment in our children's education. Strong, healthy school systems means a strong local economy, which supports a strong state economy. Please ask our Legislature to support the K-12 Education and Workforce Development Budget priorities in order to support the local community.

# Pinal County seeks help for Telegraph Fire repairs

In June 2021, Arizona's sixth largest wildfire started just south of Superior. The fire burned east, south and west, consuming 180,000 acres of Sonoran desert terrain and obliterating some of Arizona's most unique ecosystems. Once the fires were extinguished in July of 2021, the region was pummeled with record breaking monsoon storms during August and September, which created a new set of ecological and infrastructure problems for the Copper Corridor region.

During their May 12, 2022, Board of Supervisors meeting, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors voted to submit a letter to the Natural Resources Conservation Service, requesting help to repair damages to the Big Box Lake and Big Box Dam.

The Big Box Lake and Dam is important environmental infrastructure that helps to control stormwater runoff from Devil's Canyon and Mineral

Creek, which eventually deposits into the the Gila River. The dam is a 150-foot concrete arch dam constructed in the 1970s. The Big Box Lake is part of a 2002 Clean Water Act Section 404 mitigation commitment by ASARCO; the lake provides 35 acres of open water and riparian habitat. Mineral extraction companies are often required to fund a variety of environmental mitigations to ensure there is a balance of preservation to the extraction uses.

According to the information provided by ASARCO to Pinal County, the lake is generally an open-water lake. Post-Telegraph Fire, the runoff from Devil's Canyon and Mineral Creek deposited a tremendous amount of ash, sediment and woody debris that has damaged the lake and is posing risk to downstream infrastructure and Gila River habitat.

With the debris and sediment in the lake, the lake has more of a pudding like

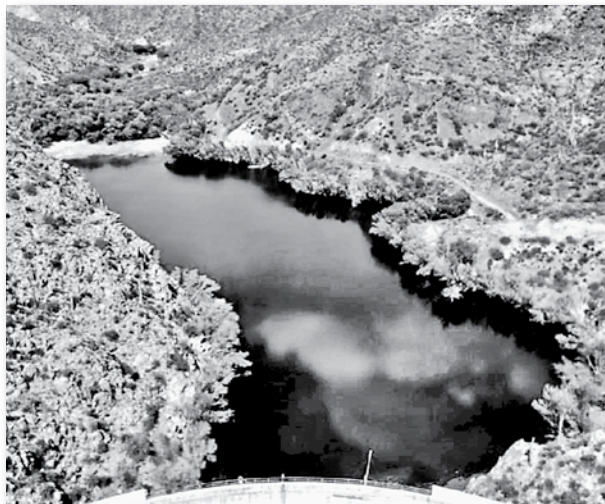

consistency. The debris in the lake is also putting stress on the dam itself.

ASARCO reached out to Pinal County to assist with the request to NCRS, as ASARCO's insurance does not cover the needed repairs and to qualify for assistance from the federal government the local political subdivision must request funding and support. The funding from the State of Arizona's Telegraph Fire appropriations funding was not able to be utilized for this project.

Pinal County requested funding through NCRS to complete a three-phase project to restore the Big Box lake and dam. The first phase of the project will clear access to the Big Box Dam Control and removal of surface debris by dredging 100,000 cubic yards and removal of sediment and debris from three areas along with cleanup of 50,000 cubic

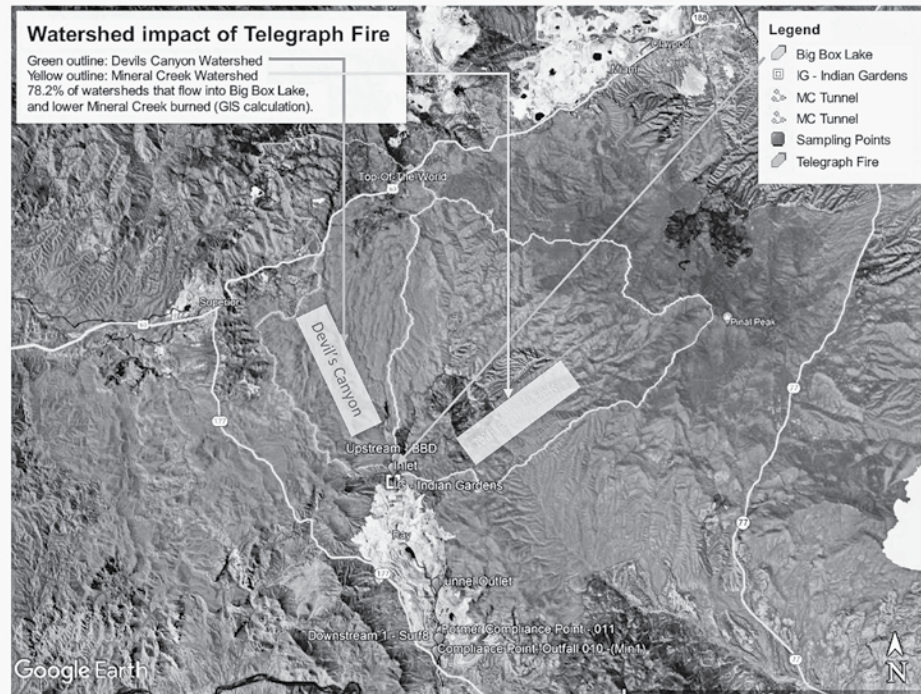
yards from the area of Devil's Canyon. Phase two objective will be to continue cleaning of the

Big Box Lake and remove debris along with an assessment of the dam's construction. Phase three

will clean the sediment deposited in natural channels by post-fire flood runoff.

# Memorial Day Tribute: Lest We Forget

**M**emorial Day over the years has become the first official start of summer. Kids are out of school. Most have the day off from work. It's usually marked with trips to the lake, backyard barbecues and local pools opening for kids and adults.

But oftentimes we forget why we have the holiday.

This is the day that has been set aside to remember those men and women who paid the ultimate price for their country, made that ultimate sacrifice.

During war times, small town America has always answered the call to duty. Many of their young men have been killed in action. One of the most extraordinary sacrifices by a small town in America happened during World War II. In the farming town of Bedford, Virginia, population 3,000, 38 young men had joined Company A in the National Guard. Most had joined during and in the years following the Depression for the \$1 a day pay, not anticipating that they would go to war. At the outbreak of the war, they were called to active duty.

On D-Day June 6, 1944, 28 of the 38 sons of Bedford participated in the mass invasion of Normandy, France which would mark the beginning of the end of the war in Europe. On that day 22 of those men would die on Omaha Beach. Most of them were killed in the first minutes of the landing. It was the highest per capita D-Day loss in the nation suffered by one community.

The survivors and the 10 men who joined the fighting a few days later would continue fighting until the war's end. They returned home, some of them physically wounded and most of them scarred emotionally and mentally by their war experiences. Their stories and the stories of their mothers, fathers, wives, friends, family, small town life and sacrifice are told

in the book *The Bedford Boys: One American Town's Ultimate D-Day Sacrifice* by Alex Kershaw.

Two sets of brothers, Bedford and Raymond Hoback and Earl and Joseph Parker were among those killed that bloody morning. Their story along with D-Day, the Omaha Beach landing and the Bedford boys is the history that the acclaimed movie *Saving Private Ryan* is based. Director of the movie Steven Spielberg would donate a large sum to the construction of a National D-Day Memorial located in Bedford, Virginia which opened in 2001.

The National D-Day Memorial honors those brave men who participated in the invasion and the 4,413 Allied soldiers who died that day in the vicious fighting to secure the beachhead.

On this Memorial Day, we honor those men who once lived in the small mining and ranching communities along the Copper Corridor and made the ultimate sacrifice for their country. May we never forget.

The names were gathered from the internet and community memorials. Where more information was available, it was listed. World War II Army dead were the hardest to find. We apologize if we have left anyone out. We would like to learn their names from family, veteran organizations or friends, so they can be honored.
