# Wildfire destroys buildings in Riverside

Last Wednesday, a wildfire in the Riverside area grew to approximately 20 acres before firefighters were able to get it under control. The Simmons Fire destroyed multiple

structures and other personal property before being extinguished.

Joanna Almaraz's home was destroyed along with an unoccupied house, several sheds, a shop building, an RV and other vehicles. Joann told the Copper Basin News that she had just changed shifts at work or she might have been asleep in her house.

There were no injuries or deaths.

According to Tiffany Davila of the State Forestry Department, the fire was sparked by someone grinding and then spread to multiple structures.

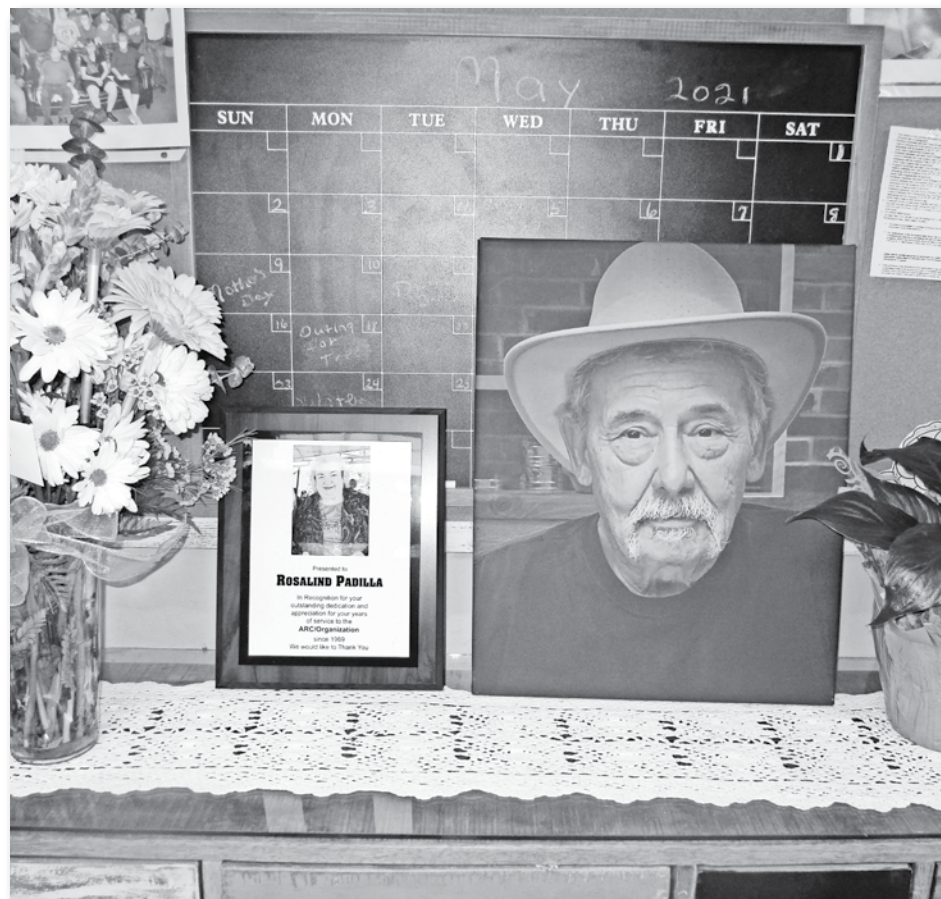

# Remembering Allen Ingram

Allen Wade Ingram was born Dec. 12, 1949. He grew up and attended elementary school and high school in San Manuel, Arizona. He was a 1967 graduate of San Manuel High School. Allen was a good athlete and competed for the Miners in football and baseball. He was well liked by all who knew him. Upon graduation, he enlisted in the Marine Corps and was sent to South Vietnam. Allen never saw his 19th birthday. He was killed in an ambush in Quang Tri Province, Vietnam.

He is honored as one of the San Manuel 7 on the San Manuel Memorial along with fellow brothers in arms: Mark A. Bateman, Juan M. Garcia, Arthur Garcia, Gary E. Graves, Norman R. Garrett and Tony R. Arriaga.

A couple of San Manuel High School alumni from the class of 1967 and friends of Allen are honoring him with a dedication of a new trophy case in his name to be placed at the high school in the foyer of the gym. Bob Acton is donating the trophy case and is working with Stephanie Bateman Beneitone to organize the dedication ceremony. Mandy Renteria from the Mammoth-San Manuel School District is assisting them. The dedication will be held on Saturday, June 19, 2021 at 10 a.m. at the high school gymnasium. The dedication is open to family, friends and all interested parties. The trophy dedication is focused on honoring Allen but it is hoped that the ceremony will bring healing to the alumni and community after the fiasco that became known as “trophygate”.

On this Memorial Day week let us remember and honor Allen Ingram and all those men and women that gave all for their country. “He who is remembered never dies.” .....Anonymous

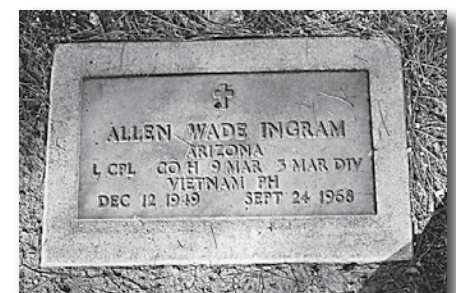
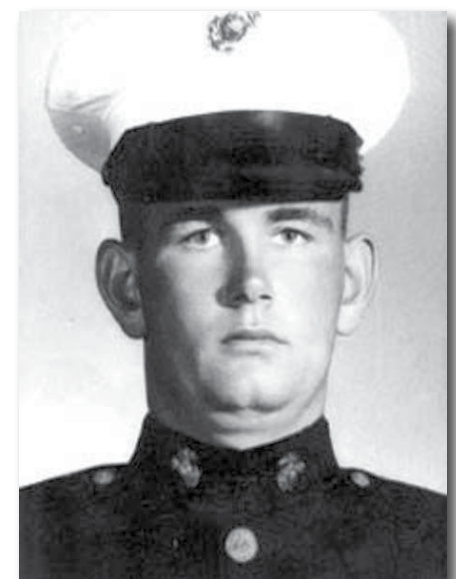
Some remembrances from some of Allen’s friends:

**CHUCK TILLER:**

As kids we were inseparable. I don’t really remember when I first met Allen. We were young, in elementary school, probably playing baseball somewhere; yet he was one of those souls that you seemed to always have known. Someone who was genuine, always there for you, a guy’s guy, a true friend. At that age, we were very close, but sadly, as people grow old, we sometime slowly drift apart or move away, as I did at 14 in 1964. One of my biggest regrets is not being able to see him and talk to him about our wonderful early times together before his tragic death in

unadulterated baseball fans, the Yankees of course. Again, we were inseparable.

I have very fond memories of Allen's parents and how they welcomed me into their household. I was at his house often for hours every day, so I quickly came to understand and appreciate how much Allen loved his parents and he meant the world to them. Mrs. Ingram was like a second mom to me. She was there when I needed someone while my mom was working at the Valley National Bank.

When my mother notified me of Allen's death, I had just turned 19 and was beginning my second year of college. Although I hadn't seen my good friend for over four years, I can't remember shedding

more tears for the passing of anyone other than my mother and father. To quote a line from the movie Stand By Me, "I never had any friends later on like the ones I had when I was twelve. Jesus does anyone?" I still think of Allen; we are inseparable. **JIM NORBY**

We went to school, played sports, and hung out through elementary school and high school. We grew up together and we knew each other well. I knew Allen as a good guy, someone who knew whatever we got into that he did not want to let his parents down or disrespect then in any way. I never doubted that Allen would be a loving spouse, a loving parent, and a dependable hard worker in whatever he chose to do. It was modeled for him for 18 years by his mom and dad and it was obvious to me throughout our lives we would be friends.

Little did I know that when two of my friends headed off for boot camp that I had seen my friend Allen for the last time. I am sure that he and Larry (Larry Davis) proudly enlisted and headed off to the Marines full of pride and ready to prove themselves. I was not there, but I can tell you that he paid attention and learned

what was expected of him and that he left for Vietnam ready to do his duty.

I remember the shock of hearing the news that he was killed in battle and have many times reflected on how and why a valuable life was sacrificed in this country far from our shores. Fifty four years have come and gone and I cannot answer the how and why and do not believe I ever will.

I am sure that all those who knew Allen like I did can and will tell you that this country and world needs all the Allen Ingrams we can get. My prayer going forward is that our leaders realize they are not sending a battalion or squadron off to war, they are sending Allen Ingrams. **LARRY DAVIS**

I am very honored to have the opportunity to speak of my friend, Allen Ingram. We grew up together in San Manuel. In grade school we walked to school early so we could play ball before we had to get to class. We hunted and fished together, and played baseball in the summer whenever there was a group of kids playing, we had a game.

Just before boot camp, we decided to float down the Gila on innertubes. Allen's dad, Cliff, drove us up the river a few miles. We had a supply of snacks

and water that we tied to the tubes, then we took off. We were having so much fun out there that it took 30 minutes for us to realize our snacks and water had all been lost somewhere along the way. We laughed about it, we knew his dad was waiting for us just a few miles down, so we'd be fine. At that time, parts of the river had fencing running across it...yep, you

guessed it, Allen's tube got snagged and had a hole. We thought about getting out of the river but Allen managed to slow the air leak with a small stick. He felt confident it would last until we met up with his dad.

A couple of hours later, hungry, thirsty, exhausted and on one tube we made it back to his dad. Cliff just smiled and helped us out

of the river and took us to Hayden for something to eat and drink. That was one adventure among many. So many great adventures!

It breaks my heart that his life ended at such a young age. Allen loved his God, his family, his friends and his country. Thank you for keeping his memory alive. Allen and all the others we lost, will never be forgotten!
