

County files application to FCC for local news coverage

During the May 18 Pinal County Board of Supervisors meeting, County Manager Leo Lew reported that Pinal County will be filing an application with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) requesting that the FCC allow local cable and satellite cable providers to show Tucson local news stations in the Oracle, SaddleBrooke, San Manuel and Mammoth areas of Pinal County.

During his verbal report to the Board of Supervisors, Mr. Lew explained that county staff has been working with local satellite television providers and they have shared that in other parts of the country, the FCC has allowed these types of modifications.

Currently, the FCC only designates the areas for local

television news coverage by county lines. Pinal County, despite its proximity to both Phoenix and Tucson, is in the Phoenix Metro news market. This became a critical safety concern for residents of Pinal County who are closer to the Tucson news market during the Big Horn Fire in 2020. The Phoenix television news markets did not cover evacuation notices and other safety information in the same way that the Tucson news market did.

Lew explained that there will be a future work session with the board to go over the next steps and what the County is doing to remedy this situation.

NOTICE OF CLOSURE:

The Arizona Department of Transportation Motor Vehicle Division (ADOT MVD) office located in San Manuel is officially closed.

This location has been temporarily closed since 2020 due to staffing issues associated with the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The lease agreement for the facility at 190 Reddington Road, San Manuel, AZ expires on June 30, 2022. ADOT has engaged in discussions with Pinal County and both parties have mutually agreed that the lease will not be extended.

The Arizona Department of Transportation will vacate the premises on or before June 30, 2022.

Pinal County has advised the ADOT MVD that they intend to utilize the facility at 190 Reddington Road, San Manuel, AZ to provide additional space for the Pinal County Sheriff's Office.

Repurposing the MVD space for use by the Pinal County Sheriff's Office may impact San Manuel, Mammoth and Oracle. Residents in these communities are able to conduct MVD business at several other physical locations in Tucson, Globe and Coolidge. Additionally, most MVD services are available online at azmvdnow.gov. Over 3 million Arizona residents currently address a majority of their license and registration needs on this site.

Sheriff Lamb, Supervisor McClure update public on state of the sheriff's office

On June 6, Pinal County Sheriff Mark Lamb hosted a town hall meeting at the San Manuel Community Center. Sheriff Lamb was accompanied by the new Pinal County District 1 Supervisor Jeff McClure, and members of the Pinal County Attorney's Office. There were more than 40 citizens in attendance.

During his speech, Lamb let the citizens know that the Sheriff's Office is, for the most part, full, with only six vacancies. He thanked the supervisors for helping get the deputies their raises. The department added on two Range Deputies, that will impact more remote areas, especially farmers and ranchers in the county.

The state gave the county between \$4.6-4.7 Million for a re-entry program.

"That's to be able to deal with mental health issues," the sheriff explained. "We're working with the county attorney's office, probation. Believe us, we're not soft on crime, we're not, but there's nothing for these folks once they get out of jail either. The re-entry program is not only going to be able to help those people transition [back into society], but also those who are struggling with drug addiction."

Sheriff Lamb acknowledged the opioid and fentanyl crisis that has been plaguing the county. One thing that Sheriff Lamb emphasized was "accountability and re-entry". He also mentioned that Pinal County has seen the crime index go down since 2017, and Lamb thanked the vigilant citizens, and those who work within the county.

New District 1 Supervisor Jeff McClure introduced himself to the citizens in attendance. He made sure to let them know that he plans to be just as involved as past Supervisor Kevin Cavanaugh. McClure acknowledged rehabilitating and re-entry for past criminals, and working on tending to those in mental health crisis in a better way. McClure also let citizens know that he is working on improving the Mammoth County Office, as to provide a better experience for the community.

School Superintendent Julie Dale-Scott voiced her appreciation for the Pinal County Sheriff's Office for their contribution to public safety. Superintendent Dale-Scott also voiced that she wants to assure her students are safe from harm, and drugs. Sheriff Lamb assured her that he is working to make sure that all schools within Pinal County are safe for students and staff.
