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# Stop illegal dumping at Oracle brush site

The Oracle Firewise Brush Disposal Site was recently the site of two illegal dumps. One individual hid about eight bags of trash underneath some brush they were dumping. The Oracle Fire Department discovered it and was able to identify the illegal dumper from mail with the dumper's address and prescription bottles found in the trash. They paid a visit to the people that illegally dumped, delivered the trash back to them and spoke to



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them. Not only were the people shamed by being caught but they have been warned that they may be banned for life from using the brush disposal site if caught again. The site is operated by the Oracle Firewise Board and the Oracle Fire Department.

The second illegal dumping was made a few days later. Not only did they illegally dump but they got into the site without paying the dump fee. These people may not be as lucky. The evidence identifying them has been turned over to the Pinal County Sheriff's Office. Illegal dumping is a crime! Illegal dumping can be a class 2 or class 1 misdemeanor. Illegal dumping of a large amount of trash can be classified as a class 6 felony punishable by up to one year in prison. The fine for a class 2 misdemeanor can be as high as \$750. A class 1 misdemeanor can result in a fine of \$2,500. The misdemeanors can also result in six months of jail time.

Illegal dumping also known as desert dumping is defined as the disposal of solid waste such as garbage, appliances, furniture, hazardous waste, tires, yard waste,

and construction and demolition debris in a location other than a landfill, waste transfer station, recycling center or curbside waste management provider. Illegal dumping costs Arizona taxpayers thousands of dollars each year for clean up and disposal. It is harmful to

the environment and poses a threat to public health and safety. Tires littering the desert or stockpiled can be fire hazards. Toxic chemicals can leak into our waterways or wells because of the illegal dumping of oil, paint, cleaners, pesticides, weed killer, etc. Illegal dump sites can be breeding

grounds for insects and rodents that can carry diseases to humans.

The Oracle Firewise Brush Disposal Site was opened eight years ago. It is an arrangement between the Oracle Fire Department, the Arizona Department of Forestry and the state land department. It was started to give residents a place to safely and inexpensively dispose of brush and shrubbery from their property. "We wanted to encourage people to dump their brush at the dump instead of the desert," said Oracle Fire Chief Larry Southard. The Oracle Fire Department's burn permit only allows for brush to be burned at the site. If they were to burn trash they stand the chance of losing their permit. It also costs the fire department time and sometimes money to clean up and dispose of the illegally dumped trash and prohibited items. The brush disposal site has signs that clearly show what can and can't be dumped at the site. They also explain in English and Spanish that illegal dumping is a crime and those violators will be prosecuted.

# New superintendent faces challenges at Oracle District

he likes being the
superintendent and loves

Oracle. "I have been at this
school 11 years and always
lived in the community,"
he said. "Right now the
school is all community
based."

Principal Nannette Soule grew up in the area. "I know a lot of people in the Tri-Community and SaddleBrooke," she said. "We have a lot of volunteers from these communities that help immensely." She also noted that the school board is great to work with. "I love it here!" said Soule.

Blauser said what he likes about being superintendent is that, "You have a lot more control over the direction the school district is going."

Blauser said that the biggest challenge for the school district will be finances. "This is a problem for all school districts," he said. "We are working hard to improve our financial situation and making progress." Blauser wanted to remind everyone about the upcoming budget override election. "We need help with the physical plant of the school district." The override is a renewal of the budget override issue of 2004 where voters approved a 15 percent increase in the district's funding. The district is trying to continue the present level of local funding, otherwise in the fiscal year 2014/15 the funding will be reduced by one-third and in fiscal year 2015/16 by

another two-thirds. Failure to renew the override will mean the district's budget will decrease by, between \$240,000 and \$270,000, which would be devastating to the school

district. Approval of the override will just renew the same tax structure and funding that has been in effect since 2004. There will be no increase in taxes!

They have 18 grandchildren: Matthew, Michael, Marie, Arlette, Kelsey, Austin, Breane,



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# Newman competes at regional meet; named Southern Arizona's Athlete of the Year All Star for track and field

Wayne Newman, graduating senior at San Manuel High School, was selected as the Southern Arizona Track and Field Male Athlete of the Year for the 2013 Spring Southern Arizona All Star Teams. According to the Arizona Daily Star's edition on June 9, 2013, selections are based on staff observations and collected statistics in consultation with area coaches. Wayne was also selected for the first team in the 110 hurdles, 300 hurdles and the long jump. Wayne took the state titles in these events at the state championship meet

in Mesa, Ariz. His time in the 110 hurdles (14.37) was the third fastest time posted at the state meet. His time in the 300 hurdles (38.41) was the fourth fastest time posted at the state meet and a new school record. His long jump of 22 ft. 8 1/4 inches was the fifth longest jump recorded at the state meet. This was three-fourths of an inch short of a new school record.

Wayne also competed in the Meet of Champions in May 2013 in Phoenix, Ariz. where he won the 110 and 300 hurdles. Wayne took second at this meet in the long jump. Wayne was selected to run for Arizona in the Southwest Classic in Albuquerque, N.M. The Southwest classic is a multi-state, allstar meet with teams as far away as Florida, Louisiana and Missouri. He was selected as co-captain for the boy's team at this meet.

Wayne competed in the

shuttle/hurdle relay where the Arizona team set a new meet record. Wayne also competed in the 300 hurdles (placing fifth); 110 hurdles (placing sixth); and the long jump (placing eighth). Wayne competed at the USA Track and Field State Meet (Mesa, Ariz.) where he won the 400 hurdles, 110 hurdles and long jump. He then competed in the USA Track and Field Junior Olympics State Meet (Mesa, Ariz.) where he won the 400 hurdles, placed second in the 110 hurdles and third in the long jump. By placing in the top four at the Junior Olympics State Meet, Wayne was eligible

to compete at the Junior Olympic Regional Meet where not only did he compete in the 110 and 400 hurdles and the long jump but he competed for the first time in the decathlon.

Wayne scored over 6,000 points winning this event by over 800 points to the next closest competitor. Wayne also won the 110 hurdles, placed second in the 400 hurdles and the long jump. These placements allowed him to be eligible to compete in the Junior Olympic Nationals, held in North Carolina.

Wayne is a Lipscomb University commit and will be beginning his freshman year in August, 2013. He will be competing in the field and track program and will begin his studies in nursing. Lipscomb University is located in Nashville, Tenn. and is a NCAA Division I, Christian university. 
















## Mammoth Elementary STEM School enjoys first day



"Oracle is a Firewise community," said Chief Southard. "Besides our volunteers, the brush dump is an important part of the system to keep it working and fire safe. It is also used to train new firefighters in fire suppression techniques during the burning of the brush piles. We can't afford to lose our burn permit because of the bad behavior of a few people, 99 percent of the people

that use the dump care about keeping it," said Southard.

The brush disposal site is open daily from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The key to the dump must be picked up at the fire station. The cost to dump a load is \$3. The \$3 goes towards the cost of operating the dump. It would be a shame to lose this site or have tighter restrictions placed on it over the behavior of few misguided people who do not seem to care about their community or the environment. If you




