Dixon Allen Faucette, 84, passed away Aug. 10, 2022, in Mesa, Arizona. He was born May 22, 1938, in Alamosa, Colorado, to Francis Allen Faucette and Cora Millie Crowther Faucette of Sanford, CO, where he grew up. He is married to Patricia Elliott Faucette. He raised six daughters.

Dixon will be lovingly remembered and genuinely missed by all that knew him. He was known for his intelligence, his sense of humor, his hard work, and his love of life. He loved to laugh, and we loved to hear that. The absence of his ever-serving hands and devotion to his family will leave a void which will be difficult, if not impossible to fill.

Dixon loved life and experienced it to the fullest. He attended Adams State College in Alamosa and worked for the D&RGW Railroad. He earned a master's degree from New Mexico Highlands and attended a Doctoral program at ASU. He loved Mathematics and taught college math, physics, chemistry and astronomy at Mesa Community College and Central Arizona College, where he received the President's Excellence Award. He served as Academic Department Chair, Instructional and Executive Dean. He would ask his children and grandchildren math questions to keep them sharp.

He loved sports; played basketball and football, coached both at Agua Fria High School, winning three state basketball championships and a runner-up in five years

and was selected as Assistant Arizona All State Basketball Coach. He bowled and won several trophies with his brothers, Walter and Phil. He loved table tennis and playing cards. Most of all he loved fly fishing and was in heaven when he was with his dad fishing, and occasionally out-fished him.

When not teaching, he built several homes. He owned a small airplane and would fly to Colorado. He liked to travel to see family. He helped family with many projects. Family was central to him. He had 9 siblings included Walt (D) and Connie, Glenn (D) and Barbara, Phil and Ginger, Paul and Elaine, Myron (D), Cora and Tom Caldon, Kelly and Sharon, David and Carolyn, and Floyd and Roberta.

Dixon raised 6 daughters. He married Sandra Goimarac and had two daughters, Cindy Sue (and Darwin Anderson), Brenda Renee (and Robert Wakefield.) He later married Rose Rice Hemmie and helped raise her daughters, Susan Hemmie Ottney and Jeanie Hemmie and they had Kristi Lynn (and Terry Peterson.) He later married Jeanette Sena who was killed in an accident in 1985. He then married Patricia Elliot in 1991 and helped raise her daughter, Melissa (and Evan Lopez), and sons, Kevin Charles and Patrick Douglas (and Terry McPeak).

He had 30 grandchildren and 40 great grandchildren, so it was always someone's birthday.



Dixon was a great man and perhaps after giving help to so many, working and serving he learned to receive and better understood receiving the gift of Eternal Life.

He loved each visit, each call, each time someone helped him and would thank all so graciously and sincerely. He loved each of his family, loved to laugh, to help others, and will be greatly missed. A special friend of 80 years is Donald Poulson.

Dixon is now with his Savior and reunited with his parents, his brothers, Walt, Glenn, and Myron. He can talk and walk and is flying high. He has learned what he needed to learn and passed the great and final examination. He bids that we learn from him and follow his good example.

Funeral services will be at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Kearny, AZ, on Friday, Aug. 19, at 11 a.m. There will be a family viewing at 10 a.m. and interment at 4 p.m. at Mountain View Cemetery, 7900 E Main St., Mesa.

CASA of Arizona Volunteer Academy coming to Payson

Now is the time to volunteer with our youth living in foster care. The CASA of Gila County Program is excited to announce that the Court Appointed Special

Advocate Program of Arizona is hosting the required CASA Volunteer training academy in Payson, AZ Aug. 25-27. For those interested in serving as a CASA Volunteer for

children from Gila County, we highly encourage you to apply before July 31, 2022 in order to attend this event. For those who do not live in the Payson area, lodging will be provided. For those who cannot attend this event in Payson, there are several alternative training dates and locations throughout the year.

"We are seeing an increase in the number of children who are being placed in out-of-home care settings," comments Coordinator Emily Nader, "We anticipate that when children return to school, we will see an increase in the number of children coming into care and our need for additional volunteers will continue to grow."

CASA volunteers provide support and advocacy for children who are either in licensed foster home, group homes, or in the care of relatives. Volunteers receive

in-depth training and ongoing support from their local program as well as from the National CASA/GAL Association. Across the nation, CASA Pre-Service Volunteer Training serves as the foundation of which every volunteer learns the principles of best interest advocacy. The curriculum has just recently been revised to highlight the shared values and build the skills, self-awareness and points of view necessary for volunteers to be most effective.

"Throughout the entire county, we have over 100 children who could benefit from a CASA being appointed to their case." Nader continued, "As a CASA volunteer, you help them find hope during a time that can be confusing and scary to a child. Every child deserves to

The boys will travel to St. David on Friday, Aug. 19, to kick off their 2022 season with a head-to-head clash with the Tigers.



Every 10 years after the official US Census is complete, Federal State and Local governments must complete a re-districting process. On July 1, 2022, the Pinal County re-districting took affect and the communities of Superior, Kearny and Winkelman join Gold Canyon, Apache Junction, Queen Valley and parts of Florence in District 5.

Jeff Serdy is the County Supervisor for District 5. He ran for County Supervisor after serving on the Apache Junction City Council and as Mayor. He decided to get involved in local politics at the municipal level when the City of Apache Junction was considering new laws on firearm dispositions. He quickly realized he

enjoyed serving and solving problems and ran for Mayor. During his term as Mayor, he focussed on marketing and promotions of the city's natural beauty and attractions.

Serdy grew up in rural community in Ohio. He has worked in a variety of professional fields including oil and gas, wildlife management, and also worked for Shamrock foods. He had the opportunity to open his own firearms store in Apache Junction and he has been focussed on his business since then.

Serving as County Supervisor since 2021, he is learning how Pinal County is quickly becoming a more urban county in many of the areas, but he sees great potential for District 5 to continue to be the part of the

county where people come to recreate.


"The major tourist attractions are in District 5, Renaissance, Lost Dutchman State Park, Goldfield Ghost Town and the Boyce Thompson Arboretum," he said.

He is a champion for the Resolution Copper project and mining in general. Serdy has been working since he was Mayor of Apache Junction and now as Pinal County Supervisor to have the Apache Trail repaired and re-opened.

"I think we can have it re-opened in two to five years" he explained.

He is an active proponent for the expansion of the Arizona freeway expansion 24, which will help to alleviate the traffic through Gold Canyon on the 60. He would also like to see Pinal County focus on bringing more jobs to the County and then the housing will come; where in the past the focus has been on building homes and then jobs would come. With new manufacturing coming to Coolidge and Casa Grande housing will be needed throughout the county.
