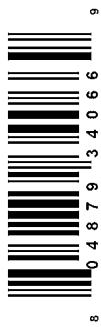

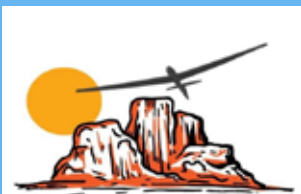

St. Francis of Assisi Fiestas Patrias set for Saturday; Copper Corridor residents invited

Superior offers a warm invitation to all Copper Corridor residents to attend the event.

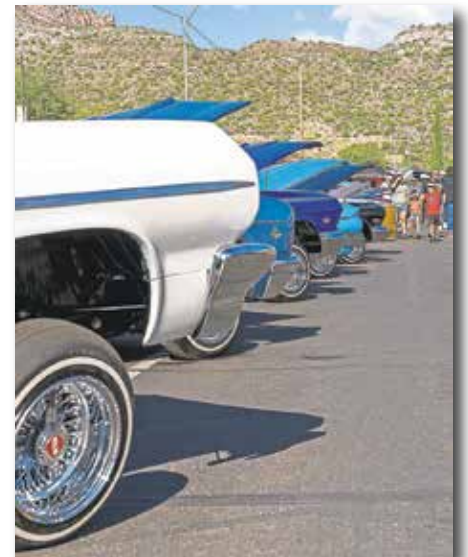
