# Lane closures, restrictions announced for Pinto Creek, Winkelman bridge projects

The Arizona Department of Transportation this week announced that daily lane closures on the US 60 Pinto Creek Bridge and lane restrictions on the SR 77 Gila River Bridge in Winkelman will both begin on Sept. 23.

Motorists on US 60 between Miami and Superior should expect daily lane closures for the Pinto Creek Bridge replacement project between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays and 7 a.m. to noon on Fridays.

Beginning in October, full closures of US 60 are tentatively scheduled between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays for about eight weeks.

Flaggers will be directing traffic. Drivers should plan for delays through the work zone.

The overall project involves constructing a new bridge adjacent to the existing bridge, and then removing the existing bridge. The project is expected to take about two years to complete.

Lane restrictions are scheduled to begin Monday, Sept. 23, on SR 77 in Winkelman as crews install temporary signals for the Gila River Bridge replacement project.

Once the new signals are in place, traffic across the bridge will be restricted to a single lane. The width limit on the bridge during construction will be 15 feet.

Motorists should expect occasional delays, especially during peak traffic hours and during scheduled closures of US 60 west of Miami for the Pinto Creek Bridge replacement project.

In addition to the lane restrictions on SR 77, Quarelli Street will be closed to traffic within the work zone.

The temporary signals will allow crews to rebuild the bridge one lane at a time.

Work is expected to continue into summer 2021.

Drivers should proceed through the work zone with caution,

slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment.

# Census address canvassers to begin knocking on local doors

The once-a-decade nationwide census is still seven months away – but Copper

Corridor residents can expect a knock at the door and personal visit soon from



**Among informational tables at the recent Hayden-Winkelman Fiesta: Gila County has a pre-census committee working to promote the 2020 census; the goal is to ensure all Gila County residents are aware of the census -- and participate in April when the census begins. An accurate count and demographic data help our county secure federal funding and congressional representation, and to plan for growth and social services. Junior Chamber volunteers Douglas Ashby and Arizona Bui were assisting during the event - and helped display the Census 2020 banner.**

US Census Bureau 'Address Canvassers' already at work verifying dwellings throughout Gila and Pinal Counties.

Dedicated Census staffer Carol was at work on Saturday of the recent Labor Day Weekend, going door-to-door politely asking residents to verify the street number – and whether the home had additional dwelling units or residents who might have otherwise been missed when the official count begins in April 2020.

Census Bureau staff want to remind and assure local residents they're being visited by an official representative of the US Census. A team of 'Decennial Census Address Canvassers' were hired to verify addresses in preparation for the April Census, and should continue through October – with permanent annual surveyors also possible in Gila and Pinal Counties.

How to know that knock on the door is legit? Census Bureau employees must present an ID badge that includes a photograph of the field representative, a Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. Workers may also be carrying a Census Bureau phone or laptop,

as well as a bag with a Census Bureau logo. Ongoing data collection activities are conducted year-round, either in person or by phone. These include:

- Current Population Survey
- American Community Survey – Housing Unit
- National Crime Victimization Survey
- National Health Interview Survey
- Consumer Expenditure Survey
- Survey of Income and Program Participation
- American Housing Survey

Residents should ask which survey they are responding to and, if they are not sure they are dealing with an official employee, to call 800-923-8282 to speak with a local Census Bureau representative. Residents suspecting suspicious activity should call local law enforcement to file a report.

Self-response for the 2020 Census should begin by mid-March, when local residents will receive a postcard inviting them to complete their nine-question survey either online or by phone. Those using a PO Box will receive a paper survey. Census Day is April 1, 2020. Read more about dates and timelines at [2020census.gov/](http://2020census.gov/)

and played with heart and emotion.”

The Bearcats have now scored 54 points in consecutive games after averaging 14 points per game in two losses to open the season.

The Hayden football team made the long trek to Sells, Ariz., to play their first road game of the year at Baboquivari. The Lobos defeated the Warriors, 42 – 20. “Our kids performed well,” Hayden head coach John Estrada told Copper Basin News. “Baboquivari was big and physical.”

Junior quarterback AJ Castillo threw four touchdown passes in the win, including a pair to senior receiver Malachi Carmelo and one each to Vince Aguirre and Gibby Carmelo, who also scored on a three-yard run. Senior Jorge Rodriguez added a 14-yard touchdown run and Damien Smith, a freshman, closed out the Lobos’ scoring with a 17-yard touchdown run.

For the second-straight week, Hayden surrendered 20 points, but the Lobos played physical defense. Junior

Josiel Rodriguez finished with a team-high four tackles. The Lobos have been nothing if not consistent in their first two games, scoring 38 then 42 points and allowing 20 points in both games, respectively.

What’s been the key to their consistent success, so far? “Hard work and improving week by week,” Estrada responded.
