# Highway work zone safety reminder: slow down, pay attention

Arizona drivers: please slow down and stay alert in highway work zones.

That's the message from the Arizona Department of Transportation, following a weekend crash in which a Department of Public Safety trooper's patrol vehicle was struck from behind along the shoulder of an Interstate 10 work zone in Phoenix.

Law enforcement reports show 61 people were killed in work zone-related crashes on local streets and highways across Arizona from 2017 to 2020. More than 850 people were killed nationwide in work zone incidents in 2020

(the most recent year for available national data).

The Arizona Department of Public Safety is investigating Saturday's non-fatal crash reportedly involving a vehicle hitting the rear of the DPS vehicle after the trooper responded to another crash near I-10 and 40th Street. The crash location was within ADOT's work zone for the ongoing I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project.

The incident serves as a reminder that drivers should obey lower speed limits and stay alert for changing traffic conditions – including slowing or stopped traffic – in all work zones. ADOT's I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project team released this I-10 work zone safety public service announcement earlier this year.

# Lobos remain undefeated with win over Cicero Prep

It was another win for the Hayden Lobos.

On Sept. 17, the Hayden football team traveled to Scottsdale Preparatory Academy to take on Cicero Prep. The Lobos once again played hard, showing their in-tune offense, who couldn't be stopped.

The whole offensive group stood out, passing for 341 yards, and rushing for 242 yards with a total of 583 total yards. Fabian Elvira threw 11-12, with 314 yards of passing and 5 touchdowns. The "two man wrecking crew" Brandon Garner and JJ Manriquez both played a big game, with Garner catching 5 passes for 128 yards and 2 touchdowns, and Manriquez catching 3 passes for 101 yards with 3 touchdowns. Moraes Cruz had 1 catch

for 47 yards and Deondre Collier had 2 catches for 38 yards. Paul Gaither finished the game throwing one pass to Mario Hong for 27 yards. Deondre Collier and Moraes Cruz led the rushing attack: Collier had 8 rushes for 107 yards and 2 touchdowns, while Cruz had 10 rushes for 52 yards and 2 touchdowns. Fabian Elvira had 1 carry for 7 yards, Kino Lorona had 2 rushes for 49 yards, and Tyler Garner had 2 rushes for 37 yards.

Defensively, the Lobos forced turnovers and did solid jobs at holding off Cicero Prep's offense. Rene Ochoa had 5 tackles, 1 assist, and 1 fumble recovery. Mathew Armenta had 3 tackles. Deondre Collier had 4 tackles. Dominic Alvarado had 4 tackles, and 1 sack. Andrew Waddell had 3 tackles, 1 sack, and 1 forced fumble. Moraes Cruz had 3 tackles, and 1 interception. Angel Moreno had 2 tackles. Brandon Garner had 2 tackles.

Keiston Pool had 1 tackle, and 1 fumble recovery. Julian Cruz had 1 tackle.

"We will continue to work hard at practice and prepare for Tempe Prep," commented assistant coach Armand Cruz.

The Lobos will travel to McClintock High School on Friday, Sept. 23, to take on the Tempe Prep Knights. The game is set to kickoff at 7 p.m.







National statistics over time have shown that 4 out of 5 victims of work zone crashes were drivers or their passengers. Arizona work zone crash statistics from law enforcement reports over the past five years include the following:

- 2017: 18 fatalities, 31 serious injuries
- 2018: 17 fatalities, 23 serious injuries

- 2019: 15 fatalities, 22 serious injuries
- 2020: 11 fatalities, 23 serious injuries

It's important for drivers to slow down and pay attention when approaching and traveling through all work zones, but especially so in areas where workers aren't able to work behind barrier walls.

Randy Everett, ADOT's Central District Administrator, emphasized

the need for drivers to stay alert and not speed in work zones during National Work Zone Awareness Week back in April.

"We have flashing lights, signs and other safety equipment, but often the biggest factor is whether a driver is impaired, speeding or distracted in some way," said Everett. "If you're entering a work zone, your first instinct should be to slow down."


