Local Superintendent Says, Wake Up Arizona

I am writing this as a concerned citizen and superintendent who wants my students back in school. I know we are all tired of the coronavirus and just want to go back to a normal life. Me, too. But we are not where we should or could be at this time. Our collective behaviors make a difference in whether people die. Consider the fact that over 200,000 Americans are dead because of coronavirus and public health agencies are predicting there will be over 400,000 deaths by Jan. 1. The promised vaccine ready by the election or soon after will have no impact on these dreadful numbers.

Unfortunately, too many Arizonans do not follow the Governor's message to "Mask Up" in public places. Wearing masks in public can save lives, it should not be debatable at this time. Those who refuse to wear masks are harming everyone, and that is a shame. I just cannot understand why everyone does not participate in this common sense, science-based strategy that will help get us back to normal, or at least a better place. If we continue to refuse to do the simple things, like wearing a mask in public, we will continue to get nowhere with the virus.

What got me upset this past weekend was simply shopping at a popular grocery chain store in the Valley and counting 22 customers without masks in one store. I was shocked because I thought it was a law. I guess not. I also watched the presidential political rallies and see little or no signs of mask wearing in the crowds. These people will come back into our communities and risk the safety of us all and delay the safe re-opening of our schools. It seems selfish to me.

The way out of this tough time is not going to be fast or easy and will require effort and leadership at all levels. The Governor has a "Mask Up" campaign that will have limited effect if everyone decides not to participate. Closing the economy is not required or even the answer if we could just agree to do a few things that make sense and could potentially reduce the amount of pain and suffering in Arizona and through the United States.

The one thing that is concerning is the lack of commitment to coronavirus testing. Dr. Fauci, the leading disease scientist at the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), has said repeatedly that we need to have more testing. Unfortunately, we are now doing less testing over the past months which seems to go against the original game plan to fight the virus.

In addition, there are many that are concerned with the CDC changing its own coronavirus testing guidelines

on Aug. 24. The new protocol no longer recommend individuals who are around someone who tests positive for coronavirus be tested themselves unless they have symptoms. This is especially alarming considering the CDC estimates that 40 percent of those who test positive for the virus are asymptomatic and can easily spread it to others. Then, just last week, the CDC reversed its guidance and now recommends individuals exposed to someone that tests positive should be tested.

This flip-flop in guidance is concerning and reduces the public's confidence in the CDC and questions the politicization of the agency that was once recognized as the gold standard in disease science throughout the world. This is especially alarming as the vaccination is being pushed forward by the CDC over the coming months. This decision negatively impacts public confidence in the agency and potentially the vaccine itself. This at a time when we need most Americans to get the COVID vaccination to eventually rid ourselves of this deadly virus.

Most medical experts believe the more coronavirus testing we do the better. Of course, initially we can expect to find more positive cases as we ramp up testing. This will then allow us to isolate those who tested positive and begin to reduce the ACTUAL cases of the coronavirus in our state and communities overtime. The most important reason we need to increase testing is to identify more asymptomatic carriers. Those without symptoms. Remember, this virus does not impact everyone the same. Some people get the coronavirus and have mild cold symptoms, or none, while others suffer greatly and die.

What we do know by now is that everyone who gets the coronavirus can spread the disease, including children. The virus wants to keep spreading because that is what this virus does well. Being an airborne disease makes it very efficient in its ability to do so. The scientific community concurs that the best approach is to find the coronavirus and isolate it to avoid community spread.

The next strategy the scientific community agrees upon is that everyone should wear masks in public to protect others. Is wearing a mask in public during the midst of a deadly pandemic too much to ask of each citizen? I do not think so. I feel that an individual's freedom should be limited if it risks the lives and safety of others. Nobody is suggesting taking away our guns; we just wanting to live safely together and as normal as possible.

It is unfortunate. The message at the top was not delivered earlier in the pandemic and isn't being modeled or endorsed in a meaningful way even today. Americans need a clear message driven by the medical experts like Dr. Fauci, which is reinforced at the top every day going forward. That is what leaders need to do and there is still time. Tell Americans the facts and the truth, and we will do extraordinary things.

The bottom line is that our individual behaviors during this pandemic do impact our state, communities, schools, families, and children. Attending large social events and shopping without wearing a mask is endangering us all. I sincerely hope that we can work together and begin to do the right things. Carbon Monoxide Detectors Can Save Your Life

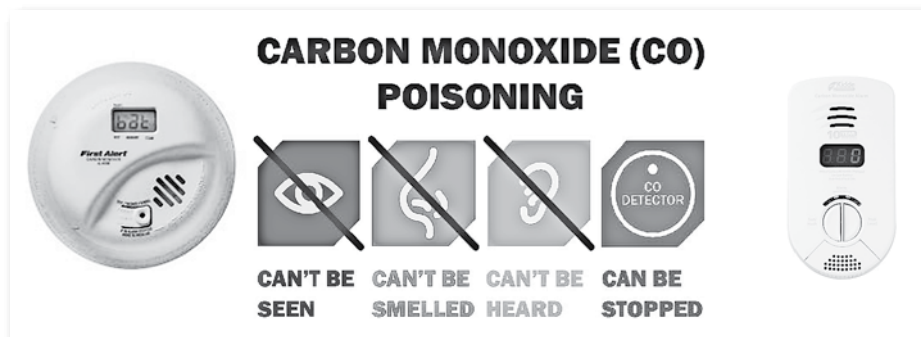
Most homes have a smoke detector. Does your home have a Carbon Monoxide Detector? Often called the invisible killer, carbon monoxide (CO) is an odorless, colorless gas created when fuels (such as gasoline, wood, coal, natural gas, propane, oil, and methane) burn incompletely. In the home, heating and cooking equipment that burn fuel are potential sources of carbon monoxide. Vehicles or generators running in an attached garage can also produce dangerous levels of carbon monoxide.

CO alarms should be installed in a central location outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home and in other locations where required by applicable

laws, codes or standards. For the best protection, interconnect all CO alarms throughout the home. When one sounds, they all sound.

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for placement and mounting height. Choose a CO alarm that is listed by a qualified testing laboratory and call your local fire department's non-emergency number to find out what number to call if the CO alarm sounds.

If your CO alarm sounds, immediately move to a fresh air location outdoors. Call 911 and make sure everyone who was inside the house is accounted for. Call for help from a fresh air location and stay there



until emergency personnel declare that it is safe to re-enter the home. To learn the warning signs of carbon

monoxide poisoning or where to place CO detectors in your home, please call the Pinal Rural Fire District at 520-465-5300.

The entire San Manuel High School athletic program will compete in the 1A Division after years competing as a 2A member.

"I think our teams can be really competitive," San Manuel Athletic Director Damon Lovato told the Miner during the summer.

According to Lovato, the enrollment cutoff between 1A and 2A is 250. San Manuel's reported enrollment was 194. Lovato was asked if the school considering appealing to petition up to 2A to remain where it had been. He stated that any enrollment below 200 eliminated a school from attempting the appeal process with the AIA.

Sports like boys' basketball, girls'

basketball, and softball have had either recent or past success in 2A, leading some to surmise those teams can perform even better as a member of 1A.

Football, one of the Miners' athletic teams that has not experienced much success in recent years, might benefit from the change.

The Miners' football team has had just two winning games in its last season, which equals the number of one-win seasons during the same time period. They went 4-6 in three of the last seven seasons.

Second-year San Manuel head coach Ernie Ivy now has a team in the 1A South Region along with Duncan, Ft. Thomas, St. David, and Valley Union.

The challenges facing the Miners do not end with their region opponents, as COVID-19 has affected the team's conditioning in addition to established

make noise after division reclassification

guidelines, which limits the number of participants who can practice together.

Ivy says he senses a greater appreciation for playing football among his players after COVID-19 threatened the 2020 season.

“The kids are working hard and are happy to be out on the field,” Ivy said.

Ivy is counting on returning players Noah

Huerta, Jonathan Rodriguez, Justin Tafoya, Mathias Medina, and TJ Madrid to lead a group of inexperienced players in 2020.

“We are a very young team with the biggest freshman class I’ve seen,” said Ivy.

A couple of newcomers – freshman quarterback Nico Velasquez and transfer Tony Guisa – are expected by Ivy to make

significant contributions this season.

Mathias, a sophomore, finished third on the team in rushing a year ago. Huerta, a junior, finished third in receiving yards.

Madrid, a senior, is the leading returning tackler from last season.

The Miners were scheduled to open their season at home on Friday, Oct. 2,

against Hayden, but the Lobos’ season was cancelled last week after the Hayden-Winkleman Unified School District announced on Sept. 14 it was cancelling fall sports. Instead, San Manuel starts its season on Friday, Oct. 9, at Duncan in what is now a five-game season – three games on the road and two at home.

AIA adjusts metric to begin competition between teams

About two weeks ago, the Arizona Interscholastic Association announced a geographical area needed 10 people or fewer per 100,000 test positive for COVID-19 to play games in contact sports such football and soccer. Last week, the AIA, with the support of its Sports Medicine Advisory Committee, adjusted the benchmark metric to 75 people or fewer per 100,000.

As a result, it appears soccer and football around the state will begin competition this week and next.

In a press release, the AIA referenced other states that have similar COVID-19 rates to Arizona that are “currently playing football with safeguards put in place by their executive boards.” The AIA believes, after “viewing these games for several weeks” that it can successfully and safely conduct football with this new benchmark.

“Seeing the positive results in other states was a big help to reach this conclusion,”

AIA Executive Director Hines said in the statement. “It’s a testament to those associations for putting proper rules in place so football can happen. We have similar numbers and similar safety recommendations as compared to those states.”

Football is the lone remaining fall sport that has not starting game competition. All other sports – golf, cross country, swimming & diving, fall soccer, badminton, and girls volleyball – have met the respective benchmarks to begin

competition.

“We have been given the opportunity to compete in football. However, it will take all of us – coaches, players, parents, fans, and administrators – to implement all of the modifications,” Hines added. “This is critical for us to stay on the current track. It is equally as critical that all involved understand the importance of adhering to the guidance of athletic trainers and medical personnel.”

Football is scheduled to commence Sept. 30-Oct. 2.

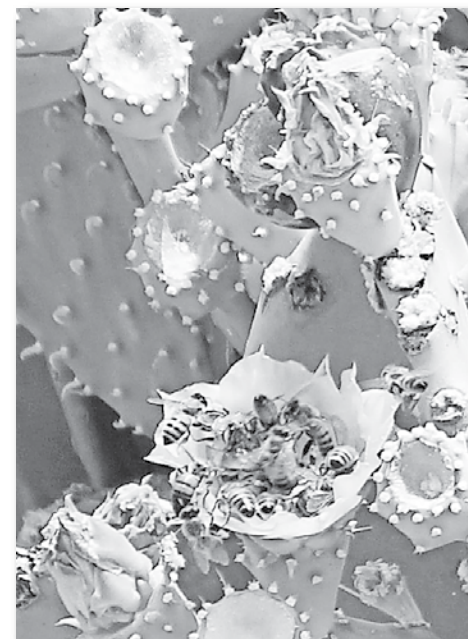
Celebrate National Honey Month with the Copper Corridor's Rancher's Daughter

program fields questions from families looking for advice and the latest child development information from early childhood experts.

FTF also funds training and support for family, friend and neighbor caregivers in regions across Arizona, including Pinal. The family friend

and neighbor strategy focuses on increasing the caregiver's knowledge and understanding of early childhood development, health and nutrition, language and literacy, and safety and injury prevention, including first aid and CPR certification as well as crib safety.

This type of training is critical in Arizona, which mirrors the rest of the country, where one-third to one-half of all children under age 5 are cared for by informal family, friends and neighbors, and in many cases, those caregivers are grandparents, who are taking care of young ones during the day.

San Manuel woman killed by drunk driver

Celeste Andresen, a resident of San Manuel and employee of the Nature Conservancy, was killed last week in Somerset County, New Jersey after being struck by a vehicle.

Andresen, according to NJ Advance Media for NJ.com, was visiting the area and out for an afternoon run

on Friday, Sept. 18, 2020, when 56-year-old Kevin D. Betyeman struck her with his pickup truck. He was cited for driving while intoxicated, reckless driving, careless driving and failure to yield to a pedestrian. The website reports that criminal charges are pending.

Andresen, 60, was an avid runner and was stopped at a designated crosswalk. Another vehicle stopped to allow her to cross the road and was more than halfway across the road when she was struck by Betyeman.

She was pronounced dead at a local hospital.

Andresen was recently interviewed by Copper Area News in a story about the Winkelman Natural Resource Conservation District. She has lived in

Copper Area News is committed to providing our readers with as much information as possible. We post a daily update on our Facebook page with the total positive COVID-19 Data. This graph shows the daily counts of positive cases for the past week as of press time on Sept. 22, 2020.

There are a few points we would like our readers to consider when following this data.

1. This will continue to be a rolling total of positive cases. It does not reflect recoveries or deaths. The Arizona Department of Health Services does not break out this data.
2. If you see a reduction in numbers from day to day it is most likely due to a data entry error or mis-coding of a zip code (at the state level).
3. This is all zip code based data; most of our zip codes include unincorporated areas. There is no way to track exactly which areas each of the positive cases are. Example, Kearny and Winkelman each have small communities in their zip code that are not in the Town's incorporated boundaries.
4. If you live in Gila County, please follow the Gila County Health and Emergency Management, Facebook. They have maintained their data on recoveries and current positive cases.
