




Highway work zone safety reminder: slow down, pay attention

Arizona drivers: please slow down and stay alert in highway work zones.

That's the message from the Arizona Department of Transportation, following a weekend crash in which a Department of Public Safety trooper's patrol vehicle was struck from behind along the shoulder of an Interstate 10 work zone in Phoenix.

Law enforcement reports show 61 people were killed in work zone-related crashes on local streets and highways across Arizona from 2017 to 2020. More than 850 people were killed nationwide in work zone incidents in 2020 (the most recent year for available national data).



The Arizona Department of Public Safety is investigating Saturday's non-fatal crash reportedly involving a vehicle hitting the rear of the DPS vehicle after the trooper responded to another crash near I-10 and 40th Street. The crash location was within ADOT's work zone for the ongoing I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project. The incident serves as a reminder that drivers should


obey lower speed limits and stay alert for changing traffic conditions – including slowing or stopped traffic – in all work zones. ADOT's I-10 Broadway Curve Improvement Project team released this I-10 work zone safety public service announcement earlier this year.







Pinal County Supervisor holds town hall in San Manuel

Pinal County District 4 Supervisor and Chairman Jeffrey McClure held a town hall and informational meeting on Thursday, Sept. 22, 2022, at the San Manuel Community Center. Chairman McClure was accompanied by Pinal County Public Works and Community Development staff to help in the sharing of information related to the Tri-Community. Several topics were covered including burn permits, Waste Voucher Disposal Program, hours of the Pinal County Office in Mammoth, and more.

The Pinal County Air Quality Department will resume issuing burn permits as of Sept. 26, 2022. The effective date of the permits will be Oct. 1, 2022. Open burning permits allow for the disposal of plant material originated on the permittee's property during limited daytime hours. There are multiple ways to obtain the burn permits.

Open Burning Permits may be obtained:
1. In-person at the Florence Pinal County Complex: Development Services Building, 85 N. Florence St, Monday through Friday

from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

2. In-person using a Kiosk at the Mammoth Pinal County Complex, 118 Catalina St. Tuesday and Thursday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Staff will be available to assist you if needed.)

3. Online (Recommended method). Customers can apply 24 hours 7 days a week, however permits are only issued Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and may take up to 24 hours to process. Online Permits can be attained at: <https://citizenaccess.pinalcountyaz.gov/CitizenAccess/Default.aspx>

Waste Voucher Disposal Program

The Waste Voucher Disposal Program, or Trash Vouchers, are now being handled by the Pinal County Public Works Department. The Waste Voucher application can be found online at <https://pinalcountyaz.seamlessdocs.com/f/wastewatervoucher>. Applicants will need to submit a copy of a current utility bill (water, power, sewer or trash) stating their name and residential address. Applicants

will also need to provide a copy of a valid Arizona State issued ID or Driver's License. All documents will be submitted via email to pcroadmaintenance.sharedmailbox@pinal.gov. The vouchers can be picked up at the Pinal County office in Mammoth after review and approval. Customers can also choose to have the vouchers mailed to them. Additional information is available by calling Public Works at 520-866-6419. It is noted that lost vouchers will not be replaced.

A total of three vouchers per year are

available for members of very limited areas in Pinal County that includes the Tri-Community. Vouchers are issued and valid on a quarterly basis.

of 5 victims of work zone crashes were drivers or their passengers. Arizona work zone crash statistics from law enforcement reports over the past five years include the following:

- 2017: 18 fatalities, 31 serious injuries

- 2018: 17 fatalities, 23 serious injuries
- 2019: 15 fatalities, 22 serious injuries
- 2020: 11 fatalities, 23 serious injuries

It's important for drivers to slow down and pay attention when approaching and traveling through all work zones, but especially so in areas where workers aren't able to work behind barrier walls.

Randy Everett, ADOT's Central District Administrator,

emphasized the need for drivers to stay alert and not speed in work zones during National Work Zone Awareness Week back in April.

"We have flashing lights, signs and other safety equipment, but often the biggest factor is whether a driver is impaired, speeding or distracted in some way," said Everett. "If you're entering a work zone, your first instinct should be to slow down."




