What birds are these? See them year-round at Oracle State Park

By Maribeth Greenslade Oracle State Park

Who at Oracle State Park flashes the colors of precious jewels, is adept at flying backwards, and is named after a 19th century French Duchess? The tiny, 10-centimeter, 4-gram, Anna's hummingbird, named after Anna Masséna, Duchess of Rivoli, that's who. Since hummingbirds are native only to the New World, the European Duchess probably never saw a live Anna's hummingbird, which was her loss!

You, however, can see Anna's hummingbirds at Oracle State Park yearround because they are the most common and abundant hummingbirds observed in the Park. Male Anna's are mostly green with a magenta head, which appears dark when not catching the light. Females lack the magenta head, have grayish underparts and often show a dark patch in the center of the throat. One of the best places in the Park to observe Anna's, as well as Broadbilled and Black-chinned hummingbirds, is the Kannally Ranch House gardens, where they use their long tongues to collect nectar from blooming plants and catch flying insects, as their hearts beat at an astounding 1260 beats per minute! Anna's hummingbirds fly very fast and are often first identified by their song which is a series of scratchy buzzes, whistles and chirps, often repeated.

Whether you are new to birdwatching or a seasoned birder, Oracle State Park is a great place to experience a great diversity of birds, due to the multiple habitats within the Park including desert scrub at the lower elevations, oak grasslands at higher elevations, as well as small pockets of riparian habitat along the washes. Occasionally we see birds more common to riparian areas along the nearby San Pedro River such as Grey Hawks, or birds that venture down into the foothills of Catalina "Sky Island" such as Stellar's Jays. Over 175 species have been observed within the Park as reported on the eBird website maintained by Cornell Lab of Ornithology, and the Park is a reliable site for Harris's Hawks, Rufous-winged Sparrows, and Crissal Thrashers among many others.

When you enjoy your next trip to the Park, take notice of the sights and sounds of the birds around you; if you are lucky you may see an Abert's Towhee foraging on the grounds for seeds and insects. Birders come from all over the world to see this large, grayish brown, long-tailed sparrow with a dark mask and pinkish bill, since it is only found in the Sonoran Desert of Arizona, surrounding states and northern Mexico. Happy trails and good birding!



You are invited to join Oracle Historical Society (OHS) for the Speaker Event: Vince Majalca – Tiger Mine History on Friday, Sept. 29, starting at 6:30 p.m. at the Acadia Ranch Museum, located at 825 E. Mt. Lemmon Hwy. in Oracle.

Vince Majalca, born in 1980 and raised in Oracle, is a graduate of San Manuel High School, class of 1998. After serving in the Army, Vince returned to Oracle where he coached San Manuel athletics and worked with at-risk teenage boys for Sycamore Canyon Academy.

In 2013, Vince earned his bachelor's in social sciences from the University of Arizona as well as his master's degree in education in 2017. He currently works for Pima Community College as the Athletic Eligibility Officer.

"This presentation was created in conjunction with Armando Carrillo Jr. who was born on March 12,1949, and raised in Tiger," said Vince. "Armando raised me alongside his son, Adam, so I have known him all of my life. Due to a personal matter, he will not be able to tell his story. I have taken the responsibility and honor to tell it for him."

"Memories of Tiger' is about growing up in the now ghost town of Tiger, Arizona. With the help of visual aids, Armando's interview, and published sources," Vince added, "we invite you to join us to revive the memories of a small mining town that like others, have become a lost piece of Arizona history." Tiger is now a ghost town buried beneath the Magma Copper/BHP open pit mine. Tiger's history goes back to the 1880s. Learn about its history and the people of what was once a community of 1,800 people. Find out how Armando Carrillo and friends were able to put a reunion of the former town's residents and their descendants together in 1996 some 42 years after they were evicted by Magma to expand the mine. The town may be gone forever but "Tiger exists in our hearts," said one of the former residents.
