Dark Sky Party and Cultural Festival coming to Oracle Sept. 21-25

The David H. Levy Arizona Dark Sky Star Party II and
The Oracle Dark Sky Cultural Festival will be coming to
the community from Sept. 21 through Sept. 25. Hosted by
Explore Scientific LLC, the multiple events will span five
days at various locations with some free events and some
events that will require purchase of tickets. The schedule
of events will be located at the end.

What does it mean to be a Dark Sky Community? It
means that there has been great effort to preserve the
night sky, and keep it from falling victim to light pollution.

Through the help of dedicated citizens, and organizations,
Oracle continues to be a Dark Sky Community.

The planning committee of Mike Weasner (Cassiopeia
Observatory), Vince Micallef (Park Manager, Oracle State
Park), Deb Gaines (President, Friends of Oracle State
Park), Alicia Bristow (President, OWN Oracle), Scott
Roberts (Founder and President, Explore Scientific, the
event organizing company) and Kent Marts (Explore
Scientific) have been organizing the event for the past
seven months.

“The preparation for the event has been ongoing with
a short planning timeframe and a challenge which we
believe the community has embraced. The planning
committee was kept small and will no doubt increase
as Explore Scientific has decide/d to make this an
annual event in Oracle, AZ. With the Oracle State
Park’s designation as an International Dark Sky it seems
logical to hold the event in this pristine area and Oracle
businesses and the community are happy to host and to
develop the companion event, Oracle Dark Sky Cultural
Festival. We hope to expand the festival next year,” Alicia
Bristow said.

The various events will include music, art, food, and
speakers giving presentations. The speakers will include
professional and amateur astrologists. The speakers will
include David H. Levy (Arizona Dark Sky Party founder),
John Barentine, Adam Block, David Eicher, Fred
Espenak, Brandon Hamil, Vince Micallef, Connie Walker,
Michael Weasner and Scott W. Roberts.

Maria’s and The Oracle Patio Cafe will all participate in





gazing, and live music, food and drinks. Nonna Maria's will be celebrating with their signature Italian cuisine. The Oracle Patio Cafe will be celebrating with food and drinks, music and stargazing.

"People around the world recognize Arizona as a tourist destination to visit our professional astronomical observatories and to experience our dark night sky. Oracle State Park, designated as an International Dark-Sky Association (IDA) 'International Dark Sky Park' in 2014, has clearly experienced a significant increase in astrotourism since 2014. Oracle State Park was selected to host the 'David H. Levy Arizona Dark Sky Star Party and The Oracle Dark Sky Cultural Festival' to be held 21-25 September 2022 and annually thereafter. Local tourism businesses and other businesses in Oracle benefit from this increased interest in astrotourism," said Mike Weasner of Cassiopeia Observatory. "This significant and exciting event is a direct result of Oracle State Park being designated as an 'International Dark Sky Park' by the International Dark-Sky Association (IDA) in 2014. There is considerable local interest in Oracle being designated as an IDA, 'International Dark Sky Community'. That would make Oracle one of only two locations of the nearly 200 "International Dark Sky Places' worldwide with both an 'International Dark Sky Park' and 'International Dark Sky Community' at the same location. Many local businesses, artists, and residents are already supporting the event in various ways. Our local, in-state, and out-of-state visitors will be supporting our local businesses. In return, we want our visitors to have the best possible day AND nighttime experience in Oracle."




